Commenced with fine breeze from N.E. heading to N.W. one sail in sight
saw 20 whales at dusk took in sail close with main topsail middle part
strong weather with rain wind hauled to N.W. & ends N.E. off

Cooper saw later L 15 by Dr. 36:35

Remarks On Board Monday Jan 22nd 1849

Commenced with light air from N.W. made sail headed to N.E. saw
nothing at dusk took in sail middle & latter part
light air & huffing at daylight made sail heading to Northward & Eastward
ends with considerable breeze from Southward steering N.W.

Broke out meet & there

Cooper better so at to come on deck & had time Long per then 173 14 E.

Remarks On Board Tuesday Jan 23rd 1849

Commenced with light breeze from V. heading to E. & haze & rain
at 1 P.M. saw land bearing N.E. steered in for it heading N.E. by Dr. 36:20
at 6. stood off shore with a light air from E. Land apparently Combs's Is.
to N.E. & heavy swell running in shore North extremity of Land from Deck
bearing N.W. at dusk double reefed the topsails middle & latter part
light air & huffing steering to N.W. without main topsail bent another

Remarks On Board Wednesday Jan 24th 1849 L 11 by Dr. 36:35 Long 172:56

Commenced with light breeze from V. heading to N. W. along shore land 12 miles distant
employed repairing main topsail saw 20 whales at dusk & had time sail middle & latter
part light breeze from E. saw a great number of porpoises at meridian saw
North Cape & three Kings so ends Cooper on deck getting well fast

Remarks On Board Thursday Jan 25th 1849

Commenced with light breeze from N.E. & fresh gale heading to N.W. & W.
caught 2 porpoises at dusk took in sail three Kings bearing N.W. North Cape
bearing N.E. by Dr. 36:35 for compass middle & latter part light air from N.
at daylight made sail & steering to N.E. by Dr. 36:35 & 20 porpoises so ends

Long 172:55 L 11 by Dr. 36:40

Remarks On Board Friday Jan 26th 1849

Commenced with moderate breeze from N.W. steering through between 2 Kings &
North Cape at 5 P.M. since shifted to V. & strong & had sail at dusk took in
sail heading N.W. by Dr. 36:35 & 20 porpoises at meridian saw
middle & latter part strong breeze at daylight set double reefs & hauled

N.E. & E. so ends

L 11 by Dr. 36:20

Long 173:30 E

Remarks On Board Saturday Jan 27th 1849

Commenced with strong breeze from V. clear weather running off N.E.
at dusk took in sail heading V.E. middle & latter part the same at daylight
set double reefs steering S.W. by Dr. 36:35 saw nothing broke out another 4 miles

Long 174:32 E L 11 by Dr. 36:30

Remarks On Board Sunday Jan 28th 1849

Commenced with fresh breeze from V. fine weather steering E.N.E. saw nothing
at dusk took in sail middle & latter part light air set all sail saw
nothing V. ends

L 11 by Dr. 36:19
Long 175:35

Remarks On Board Monday Jan 29th 1849

Commenced with light air from N.E. heading to N.W. saw
nothing at dusk took in sail middle & latter part light air
from Southward caught a porpoise so ends

Long 175:45 L 11 by Dr. 36:08

Remarks On Board Tuesday Jan 30th 1849

Commenced with light air from N. heading to E. saw nothing
at dusk took in sail middle & latter part the same saw
grampasses & porpoises ship heading around the compass

Long 175:40 E

Remarks On Board Wednesday Jan 31st 1849

Commenced with light huffing air clear saw nothing at dusk took
in sail heading to V.E. middle part light air latter part fine breeze
from N. all sail set heading to E. people employed on rigging saw nothing

Long per then 176:05 L 11 by Dr. 36:26

Remarks On Board Thursday February 1st 1849

Commenced with fine breeze from N. heading to E. at dusk took
sail middle part the same latter part the weather good saw
20 whales of Blackfish going quick people employed on
rigging

Long 176:53
