at 7 PM took in sail & broke out sail to E. ends

Remarks On Board Saturday Feb. 3. 1849

Commenced with fresh breezes from E. & E. heading to N. at dusk shortened sail middle part the same latter part strong breeze at daylight set topsails at 4 AM about ship heading E. & E. at 8 AM able to set to ends

Remarks On Board Sunday Feb. 4. 1849

Commenced with strong breezes from N. & E. ship heading to E. by the wind thick weather at dusk took in sail middle & latter part the same had a run with a fore mast hand set him aloft ship heading to E. & E. ends

Commenced with strong breezes from N. & E. ship heading to E. by the wind at dusk took in sail middle & latter part the same the same latter part more moderate sheet out reef saw nothing employed at various jobs

Commenced with fresh breezes from N. & E. ship heading to E. by the wind at dusk took in sail middle & latter part the same the same saw nothing employed at various jobs

Commenced with fine weather winds E. heading to N. at dusk could reef middle part the same latter part wind haul more to E. & E. at daylight made all sail & steered W. & E. saw nothing broke out provision hands employed at various jobs on rigging

Remarks On Board Thursday Feb. 8. 1849

Commenced with fresh breezes from E. & E. & pleasant steering to the N. & E. commenced standing haul watches middle & latter part & latter part the same at 10 AM set sail & set aloft fore topsail & sent to ends

Remarks On Board Friday Feb. 9. 1849

Commenced with strong breezes from E. & E. heading to N. at 5 PM strike Barge Marchus of S. & P. harbor 15 months out 200 M. middle part the same able reef the topsails at daylight saw French Rock bearing N. 83 miles Dist passed to E. & E. at 10 AM took in job Marchus in sight return to ends
Long 178.34 W Lat 31.13 N

Remarks On Board Saturday Feb. 10. 1849

Commenced with strong breezes from E. & E. passing up calls heading N. & E. at 2 PM took in main sail at dusk took in fore topsail & last reef main middle part lay in for latter part set double reef steered N. & E. at 7 PM set & Macaulay Island bearing N. 20 miles Dist Marchus in sight to ends
Long 178.30 W Lat 30.15

Remarks On Board Sunday Feb. 11. 1849

Commenced with strong breezes from E. & E. all prudent sail set steering S. & E. by N. middle part the same latter part more moderate at daylight made all sail fine weather under North course N. & E.

Remarks On Board Monday Feb. 12. 1849

Commenced with moderate breezes from South & pleasant steering N. & E. middle & latter part light air & calm saw nothing employed repairing Bowsprit & set to ends

Remarks On Board Tuesday Feb. 13. 1849

Commenced with calm & some clouds at daylight air from W. & E. part the same latter part severe rain & huffling winds saw 2 sails to ends
Lat 26.25 N Lat 27.50
