

Remarks On Board Friday June 15th 1849

Commenced with fresh gales from W. laying the head in shore at 4 PM spoke Margaret Port New Bedford 18 months and 600 middle part. fine letter part fresh breeze chasing whales in company with 17 ships & struck last whale & hauling, got nothing so Ends

Remarks On Board Saturday June 16th

Commenced with strong breeze from W. & evening off and on shore chasing whales got nothing at dusk took in sail heading off shore middle & letter part fine weather at daylight made sail saw whales lowered 1st Boat struck one took him through side so Ends



Long 135.5-9 Lat 42 40 N

Remarks On Board Sunday June 17th

Commenced with fine weather employed cutting whale finished at 4 PM lowered for whale & Boat struck whale head & started cut from him in day middle & letter part the same commenced boiling so Ends

Remarks On Board Monday June 18th

Commenced with thick fog winds from N.E. at dusk set watch heading to E.S.E. middle & letter part moderate at daylight cleared up main sail saw 10 whales employed boiling & setting up aboard so Ends Long 135.00 Lat 42.32

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 19th

Commenced with fine weather several whales in sight doing nothing at dusk set the watch. calm middle part clear letter part fog & light air from W finished boiling commenced stowing down so Ends No Litterstowing East

Remarks On Board Wednesday June 20th

Commenced with thick fog winds W. & steering E. finished stowing down saw down 10 fobs at dusk took in sail middle part thick fog letter part partly clear & steering N.E. along shore boat in sight so Ends whales in sight

Lat 43 09 N
Long 135 22 E

Remarks On Board Thursday June 21st 1849

Commenced with fine weather wind W. lowered for whale & lowered Boat struck but him lot 2 aims 1 spoke got shore at 4 PM lowered again to no purpose at dusk took in sail made part clear letter part fog lowered in the morning for whales to no purpose Ends repairing at Boat

Remarks On Board Friday June 22nd

Commenced with thick fog winds W. steering N.E. at 6 PM took in sail middle part fog letter part fog & calm a number of whales close to the ship to fog to lower for them at the lights Ends with thick fog

No Lat. by reckoning 43 35 N
Long by do 135 50 E.

Remarks On Board Saturday June 23rd

Commenced with thick fog at 4 PM light up lowered 2 Boats to lower a whale fog came on board several whales around a dusk took in sail & heading E winds N.W. middle part the same letter part strong N.E. winds & heavy weather set double reef topsails cruising employed cutting over water east so Ends Long of ship by lead 136.21 E. 137.13 E very pretty Lat 43.41

Remarks On Board Sunday June 24th

Commenced with strong breeze from N.E. cruising saw 1 Right whale & 2 fin backs saw 1 carcass at dusk took in sail middle & letter part middle & letter part mostly fog saw 2 whales lowered for them went on Boatstower did not start so Ends with fog

No Lat. 42 20

Remarks On Board Monday June 25th

Commenced with fog & light air from E. steering N.E. at dusk shot first sail to haul main & double reef topsails & jib middle & letter part thick fog winds shifted to N.E. at midnight headed to E.S.E. at 8 AM veered ship to N.W. so Ends No Lat

Lat No by reckoning 43.45

Remarks On Board Tuesday June 26th

Commenced with strong breeze from N.E. & thick fog ship heading to E. the wind under double reef topsails at 4 PM took in fore & close reef middle part the same letter part rain with a fresh gale so Ends ship head to V.E. winds more easterly
