

Remarks On Board Monday July 9th 1847

Commenced with light breeze from N.E. clear weather standing off and the land at 11 AM. saw whales lowered missed one at dusk double reef the topsails heading off E.N.E. finished repairing sail Boat middle & latter part fog commenced boiling employed cutting of pipes so ending 13635 Lat 43° 29'

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 10th 1847

Commenced with light breeze & fog ship heading to N.E. & E. of the wind at 1 PM cooled down shipworks at dusk shortened sail middle & latter part mostly fog at day light made sail commenced boiling heading to Eastward saw a great number of pinbacks at Ends

Lat 43° 18'

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 11th 1847

Commenced with N.E. wind & passing fog saw two Right whales lowered for on the N. purpose at dusk shortened sail heading to N.E. middle part, ship & Endeavour latter part the same at 11 PM took in sail employed boiling Lat 43° 30' N.

Remarks On Board Thursday July 12th

Commenced with moderate gale from N.E. ship heading to N.E. & W. finished boiling at dusk middle & latter part strong N.E. wind at daylight commenced steaming, down chock off the main hatch put down 54 lbs 20 Ends Lat 43° 23' Long 136° 10' E.

Remarks On Board Friday July 13th Commenced with N.E. wind

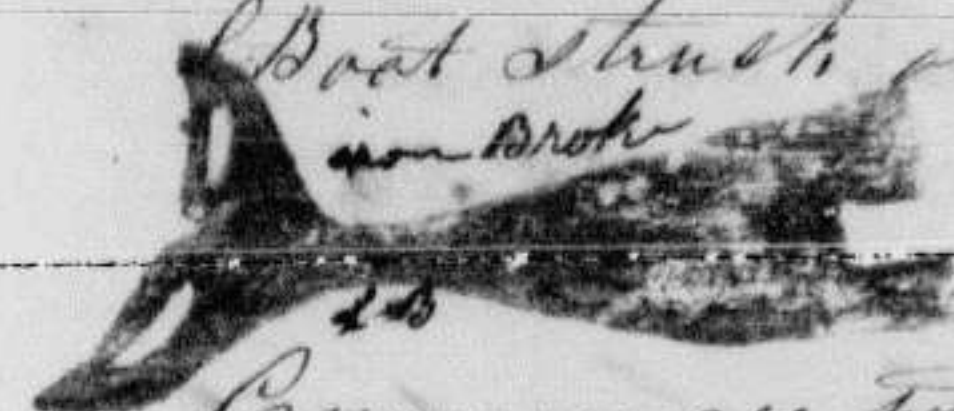
at 1 PM made sail heading to N.E. at 4 PM saw a whale lowered for him at dusk took in sail land in sight to N.W. 24 miles Just middle & latter part mostly calm saw whales lowered started N.E. one sail in sight Lat 43° 06' N.

Remarks On Board Saturday July 14th

Commenced with baffling air saw whales lowered started N.E. at dusk calm shortened sail middle & latter part fog & calm spoke Barin Am of shipboard 3 1/2 months out 23 W. whale this season Lat 43° 03' N.

Remarks On Board Monday July 15th 1847

Commenced with light breeze & fog saw several whales to windward did not lower at dusk headed to N.W. middle part tacked to E. at day light saw whales lowered several times too foggy to do much started at sunset Boat struck one iron broke but whale so ending 13638 Lat 43° 10'



Remarks On Board Monday July 16th 1847

Commenced with light breeze from N.E. some clear weather chasing a whale missed one at dusk shortened sail whales in sight middle & latter part mostly fog a plenty of whales in sight lowered at 11 PM took a whale got him along side at Ends Lat 42° 57' Long 136° 20'



Remarks On Board Tuesday July 17th

Commenced with light breeze from W. fog employed cutting and in sight at dusk set watch commenced boiling middle & latter part fine employed from 6 AM boiling & steaming Boat struck one took line W. Boat struck one iron broke so ending 13639 Lat 43° 10'



Remarks On Board Wednesday July 18th

Commenced with fine weather wind S.W. employed boiling & setting up shrouds at 1 PM lowered Boat struck a whale took him along side made him fast for the night middle part clear latter part foggy employed cutting finished at noon employed Boiling 3 ships in sight one cutting Lat 42° 59'



Remarks On Board Thursday July 19th Commenced with fog

at 2 PM clear up wind S.W. employed stowing down & boiling middle & latter part fog employed boiling & stowing down saw several ships at Ends Lat 43° 03' N.

Remarks On Board Friday July 20th

Commenced with light breeze & some fog from E. spoke the Trip of Soc Bedford to sail in sight middle & latter part fog stowing down at noon clear up some one sailing sight saw 2 whales at Ends so Lat 43° 03' N.
