

Remarks On Board Saturday July 21st

Commences with moderate breeze from W. some fog at 6 PM headed to E. employed boiling middle & latter part fresh breeze finished boiling at 10 PM employed stowing down 6 sail in sight spoke the *Mar. Hammett* of New Bedford 2910 tons so Endeavour 136 1/2 E. Lat 43 28

Remarks On Board Sunday July 22nd

Commences with fine breeze from W. steering along shore to SE. saw nothing at dusk shortened sail heading to ESE middle & latter part fine weather saw nothing steering in for the land

Remarks On Board Monday July 23rd

Commences with fine weather saw one whale going north to E. stood in shore until 4 PM spoke *Midas* of New Bedford shortened sail stood off for the night middle & latter part fine weather E. employed stowing down 20 Endeavour 6 ships in sight no one whaling land in sight Lat 43 38 N

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 24th Commences with fine weather wind W. ship steering to SE by D all hands employed stowing down at dusk shortened sail middle & latter part fine weather saw 2 ships & no whales steering to NE

Remarks On Board Wednesday July 25th 1849

Commences with fine weather steering to N. until 5 PM shot in shot for hauled up East under 2 topsails, jib & main top gallant sail middle & latter winds N. E. stood in shore saw nothing saw fog

Remarks On Board Thursday July 26th 1849 Lat 44 23 Commences with fresh breeze from E. N. E. stood to NW. at 6 PM saw 2 whales lowered to 10 PM shortened sail to 2 topsails middle & latter part steering South weather the same saw no whales so Endeavour

Remarks On Board Friday July 27th

Commences with fresh breeze from N. E. all sail set steering North heavy weather at 6 PM saw 2 ships whaling shortened sail to main top sail middle part the same latter part clear saw both ships some chasing whales some boiling saw 2 whales so Endeavour Lat 42 45 N

Remarks On Board Saturday July 28th

Commences with light air from N. steering to SE lowered for one whale to No purpose at dusk shortened sail middle & latter part fine saw 2 whales headed to No purpose 12 ships in sight so Endeavour

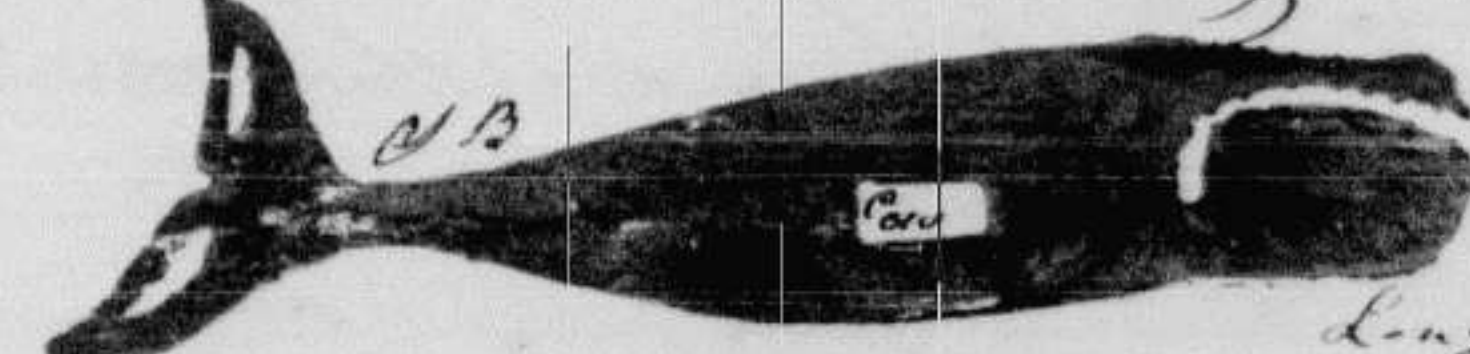

Remarks On Board Sunday July 29th

Commences with light baffling breeze saw 2 whales chased them to No purpose at dusk took in heaving to 10 PM ship in sight & boiling middle & latter part fine weather chasing whales so Endeavour Lat 42 25 Long 137 06

Remarks On Board Monday July 30th

Commences with fine weather chasing whale at dusk at dusk 1st whale came on board at dusk middle & latter part the same at 10 PM 1st whale lowered 2 Boat struck on parted line lost him at 9 AM lowered again 2 Boat struck on saved him took him along side hooked on got dinner so Endeavour

Remarks On Board Tuesday July 31st

Commences with fine weather employed cutting finished at dusk commenced boiling & put the ship *Herald* Macomber master Jacobs this season middle & latter part fog employed boiling & cutting up sheds Lat 42 38 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday August 1st 1849

Commences with heavy weather winds W. employed boiling chased whale at dusk whaled up. Endeavour with fine weather steamed Boat lowered 8 times to day got nothing saw in sight & several ships Lat 42 38 N
