

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 12th

Commenced with strong breezes from E. ship heading to W. by the wind at 8 P.M. took in light sails at 8 P.M. took in mizzen top sail single reef fore & main at 8 P.M. made to middle part fine weather latter high fog heading to W. all night from 7 until 10 P.M. stood to S. & tried the current found it running to S. E. apparently strong. No Lett by Br.

Remarks On Board Thursday Sept 13th

Commenced with light airs from E. E. ship heading to N. E. at 1 P.M. tried current found it setting W. S. W. strong at 2 P.M. calm at 8 cast away tried current again found it setting N. by N. at 7 P.M. calm middle & latter part some light air from N. E. at 10 P.M. clear up found our ship about 12 miles off shore of the S. E. part of Siphon in Lett by Br. at 40° 18' N Long 142° 12' by Land East

Remarks On Board Friday Sept 14th

Commenced with calm tried the current found it setting W. N. in shore at 6 P.M. found it setting S. E. had a light breeze from N. E. ship heading E. W. E. at dusk judge the Land 15 miles off to N. W. middle part calm latter part very light airs from N. E. saw blackfly hauled for them struck & drawn & in the at 10 P.M. clear up saw land close to in W. found by Lett. the current had set the ship 35 miles to N. East by Br. at 40° 39' 45" N Long 142° 44' per Chron. Lett by Br. 39 45

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 15th

Commenced with moderate breeze from W. N. E. & clear steering to E. by S. all sail set middle part fine weather latter part the same put out waist sheet and up fore top gallant yard all sail set at distance to Ende course East Long 144° 00' Lett 40 16

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 16th

Commenced with fine weather wind W. N. W. steering East saw funnels middle & latter part passing squalls of fog one ship in sight to Ende Long by Reck 147° 22' E Lett by Br. 42° 22' N

Remarks On Board Monday Sept 17th

Commenced with fine breeze from W. steering E. N. E. passing fog squalls ship in sight middle & latter part fine weather water employed at various jobs set main top gallant & steering sail to Ende Lett 41 44 N Long 148° 00' East

Remarks On Board Tuesday Sept 18th 1847

Commenced with fine breeze from W. N. W. clear steering E. N. E. all sail set middle & latter part strong breeze taking in & making sail as occasion requires steering E. N. E. so Ende Long 153° 56' E Lett 40 12 N

Remarks On Board Wednesday Sept 19th

Commenced with strong breeze from W. N. W. all sail set steering E. N. E. middle & latter part fine weather employed making sprays for to bunch bone and nothing to Ende Lett 40 26 N Long 157° 00' E

Remarks on Board Thursday Sept 20th

Commenced with fine breeze from W. N. W. steering E. N. E. all sail set clear weather middle & latter part the same employed cooping bread saw black fly N. Ende Long 157° 20' E Lett 40 16 N

Remarks On Board Friday Sept 21st

Commenced with fine breeze from W. N. W. steering East all sail set saw black fly with a Lunar. finished cooping bread stored it below middle & latter part the same employed cutting over papers for water saw nothing to Ende Lett 40 26 N Long 162° 42' E

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 22nd

Commenced with fine breeze from W. N. W. steering East all sail set cooping bread brought a tierce of Beef middle & latter part the same saw funnels to Ende took a Lunar Long 165° 07' Lett 40 26

Remarks On Board Sunday Sept 23rd

Commenced with fine weather steering E. N. E. all sail set wind W. N. W. middle part the same latter part wind hauled to W. at 4 P.M. ship set under way to Ende in thursail to Ende Lett 41 06 N Long 167° 00' E
