Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. ship steering N.E. all sail set at dusk but light of the land bearing S.W. chose watch middle & latter part the same employed putting boats & cutting foremast. Steering by E. & E. ends shipped & furnished. That & lower away on board.

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.E. all sail set steering N. employed getting ready for whale middle & latter part the same all sail set course South employed breaking out water & nothing haul. No Ends

Commenced with strong breezes course South employed putting cutter gear & breaking out small stores middle & latter part strong breezes & some rain Long 158 45 W Let 15 10 S

Commenced with strong breezes from E. & carrying all sail course N. cloudy some rain. 2^d mate sick off duty has bin for 4 days middle & latter part squalls with rain employed putting cutting gear Mr. Norton some better. No Ends

Remarks On Board Tuesday Nov 20th

Commenced with strong breezes with severe squalls steering N.E. all prudently set. Middle & latter the same saw nothing. Mr. Norton the same. No Ends Long 159 40 W Let 10 21 S

Remarks On Board Wednesday Nov 21st

Commenced with strong breezes from E. & passing squalls taking in making sail as required. Carried away fore topmast back splinter middle & latter part squalls & hailing with severe rain & nothing haul. No Ends

Remarks On Board Thursday Nov 22nd 1849

Commenced with light hailing air from E. with rain & cloudy at 12 M strong squalls from N.E. took in topmast back middle & latter part light air. Deane employed at putting rigging & sent up main royal yard.

Remarks On Board Friday Nov 23rd

Commenced with light air from N.E. ship heading to N.W. by the wind saw nothing middle & latter part the same with severe rain caught east of water. Mr. Norton some better. No Ends

Commenced with light breezes from E. & E. all sail set steering N. & chose boats crew put out the boat middle part moderate breezes & clear latter hailing with rain. No Ends Long

Commenced with light hailing air & rain saw nothing several men sick Mr. Norton some better middle & latter part the same ship heading to N.W. several sick ones some getting better.

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. heading to N.W. & M. saw Blackbird lowered to N. purpose middle part calm latter part moderate breezes from N.E. & pleasant ambient temperature. No haul new main one saw nothing Long 159 40 W Let 5 28 S

Remarks On Board Tuesday Nov 27th

Commenced with light air from N.E. heading to N.W. by the wind purposes middle & latter part passing squalls of wind & rain at day light saw Washington Island bearing N.W. 8 miles. No haul up for it.
