Commenced with moderate breezes from N.E. all sail set and with sea running smooth middle part the same latter part more moderate employed fitting boats & set main & foremast shrouding sail & set some other

Remarks On Board Tuesday, Feb 19th 1840
Commenced with fine breezes from N.E. all sail set course S.W. by W. employed at various jobs middle part much the same latter part away to the breeze shrouding sail & set both sides kept getting better people employed & rigging etc. Ends

Remarks On Board Wednesday, Feb 20th

Commenced with moderate breezes from N.E. course S.W. all sail set clear weather & sea fine middle part, latter part the same employed at various jobs on rigging etc. Ends

Remarks On Board Thursday, Feb 21st 1840
Commenced with fine weather course S.W. by W. 176 23
all sail set and with fine middle & latter part fresh breeze employed making out weather etc. Ends at noon said to open a whale

Remarks On Board Friday, Feb 22nd

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. course S.W. by W. and open sea. Lawrence for him to go forward bore up on our course at 4 PM saw several whales & lost track & killed one took him along side took a good middle & latter part



strong breezes & squalls, at 6 AM commenced cutting fins & to some took from the whale about 6000 pounds of Ambrosia bare up on our course S.W.

Remarks On Board Saturday, Feb 23rd

Commenced with fresh breezes from N.E. all prudent sail set and open sea observed & docks commenced boiling middle part & latter the same employed boiling said nothing etc. Ends

Remarks On Board Sunday, Feb 24th

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. all sail set course S.W. by W. employed boiling at dusk took 2000 lbs of oil & 1000 lbs of fish at 10 PM shrouding sail middle part strong breezes & squalls double reef topsails latter part fresh gales & rain squalls from N.E. took in fish & fire topped finished boiling at 1 PM whale turned up 40 fms ends with fresh gales shrouding etc. Ends

Remarks On Board Monday, Feb 25th

Commenced with fresh gales from N.E. & severe rain squalls course S.W. by W. with double reef main topsail & fore sail at dusk had the foremast up a topmast sent down fore top gallant and sent up fore & fore reef main topsail & fore mast heading to N.W. middle part moderate latter part better weather employed shrouding & darning bore up N.W. made sail etc. Ends
Long 176 00 Lat 18 03 by Reck 18 30

Remarks On Board Tuesday, Feb 26th

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. course S.W. by W. all prudent sail set finished shrouding whale strand down 38 fms at dusk single reef fore & main topsail set main top gallant sail middle part strong breezes & passing squalls at daylight made all sail hauled up & by E. sent with fine weather sent up top gallant & sent fore reef etc. Ends

Remarks On Board Wednesday, Feb 27th

Commenced with strong breezes from N.E. all sail set course S.W. by E. with strong & carpentering made on middle & latter part winds hauled to E. & some rain squalls etc. Ends
