Commenced with light breezes from E & rain squalls at 4 P.M.
 color many clouds across the horizon middle part
 light rain latter part breeze from N. heading to S. E.
 by the wind find a current setting to S. E.

Long 111° 11' E Lat 14° 02'

Remarks Onboard Friday Mar 29th 1850

Commenced with light baffling airs from S.W. with rain & 1
 passing, clouds of wind middle part the same latter part
 some severe squalls of wind & rain at 1 P.M. double reef
 the topsails

Lat 13° 45' N Long 111° 58' E

Remarks Onboard Saturday Mar 30th

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. all abundant sail set
 heading to S. E. by the wind with passing squalls of wind &
 rain middle part the same latter part more moderate
 with fine weather employed getting ready for topsail & jib to haul
 the Ensign ship heading S. E. by the wind S.W. Lat 13° 53' N

Remarks Onboard Sunday Mar 31st 1850
 Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. & heavy weather heading to
 S. E. by the wind but more squalls & jib & or 3 masts men
 middle part & latter the same at daylight set all
 sail to Ensign saw nothing Lat 12° 00' N
 Long 150° 00' E

Remarks Onboard Monday April 1st 1850

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. all sail set
 heading to S. E. by the wind clear weather
 middle & latter part severe rain squalls & baffling
 winds heading to S. E. Lat 11° 22' N Long 178° 46' W

Remarks Onboard Tuesday April 2nd

Commenced with light baffling breezes from N. to S.W. with
 the N. E. all abundant sail set saw porpoises middle part
 severe rain latter part fine weather by 1 P.M. employed
 repairing Round house sail mending & darning & c. Lat 10° 33' N

Remarks Onboard Wednesday April 3rd

Commenced with light airs & calms heading to S. E. all sail
 set employed at various jobs middle part & latter by 1 P.M. employed
 sail mending & various other jobs heading to S. E. Lat 10° 00' N
 Long 178° 30' W

Remarks Onboard Thursday April 4th

Commenced with light airs from E & calms & passing showers
 ship heading to S.W. by the wind employed at various jobs middle
 & latter part fine weather employed painting the Boat and
 other jobs & to Ensign took 2 lunar obs. Lat 11° 33' N

Remarks Onboard Friday April 5th

Commenced with light airs from S. E. all sail set course S. E. by
 some passing showers middle & latter part fine weather ship
 North employed painting Boats & to Ensign saw 2 finbacks
 took 2 lunar obs. Lat 13° 54' N
 Long 178° 40' W

Remarks Onboard Saturday April 6th

Commenced with clear weather & light airs from N. E.
 all sail set steering North middle & latter part
 fresh breezes from S.W. heading to S. E. by the wind
 employed painting Boat Lat 8° 33' N
 Long 177° 54' W
