by the wind all prudent did not comply with setting up rigging
middle & latter part fine breeze & clear weather employed

Commenced with fine weather & moderate breeze from
from S.W. & E. respectively & S.W. by the rings saw nothing

Commenced with ash breeze from E. E. course N. W. all sail set

Commenced with light breezes from N.E. with passing
showers of rain. Course N.E. Wind sail set at 4 P.M.
arrived here Easterly Sea nothing middle & latter part
severe rain & squalls of wind. No Ende cut off by the
11th Nov. M. 1892
