Remarks Onboard Monday April 26th

Commenced with moderate gales from S. E. accompanied with
strong breeze heading to N. E. & E. the wind under double reef
& fore sail of 4 P.M. fore sail middle part the same latter
part stronger breeze both in fore & main sail at 4 P.M.

Commenced with moderate gales & passing squalls from N. E.
heading to N. E. the wind at 4 P.M. also with fore & main
