

Remarks Onboard Tuesday May 7th 1850

Commenced with fresh breezes from N. steering North lost in main top sail & by jib passing plumes of rain carpenter at work on companion way middle part stem. breezes from N. steering to E. by the wind at 11 AM passed 2 carcasses set main sail carpenter at work on E. end

Left N. O. by 43 30 E

Remarks Onboard Wednesday May 8th 1850

Commenced with fresh breezes from N. at 2 PM. about one reef flat the top sail & set percenter lashing on main topmast at 4 PM. so main top gallant set windward water by heading S. V. middle & latter part the same all pieces of sail set

Left by 44 20 W

Long 169 30 East

Remarks Onboard Thursday May 9th

Commenced with strong breezes & passing plumes from N. all pieces of sail set heading S. E. broke out meet and nothing middle & latter part more moderate at 9 AM more all sail saw fin backs one W. 12 E. Left 45 10 North

Remarks Onboard Friday May 10th

Commenced with moderate breezes from N. W. & clear all sail set heading to W. & S. by the wind saw fin backs middle & latter part strong breezes & heading to W. course S. W. at 8 AM commenced unrigging foremast sent in by jib down & down fore top gallant mast so ends plenty fin backs in sight

Remarks Onboard Saturday May 11th

Commenced with strong breezes from N. E. thick steering S. W. all sail set at employed lashing & pass & by jib over the stern at 6 PM single reef the top sail set last middle & latter part middle & latter part at 6 PM the same steering S. W. & S. saw nothing so ends broke out & latter

Remarks Onboard Sunday May 12th

Commenced with strong breezes & fog from N. W. steering S. W. by 1 PM about 6 reef the top sail took in jib at 4 PM. winds hauled off by middle & latter part variable at day by hot North in main sail & fore top sail at 4 set the... which one reef out the top sail heading North by the same Left by 48 00 by 49 04 W

Long 172 35 E

Remarks Onboard Monday May 13th

Commenced with fresh breezes from N. W. all sail set at 7 PM. more ship heading to the middle part calm latter part moderate breezes from N. E. steering S. W. saw 2 whales near the last night of them in fog sent down stunsail books so ends

Left N. O. by 51 40

Remarks Onboard Tuesday May 14th

Commenced with light breezes from N. E. steering S. W. all sail set passing for squalls shot & red bill loosed & back picked him up middle & latter part foggy lay with main top sail aback from 12 PM to 1 PM 3 AM here up & W. saw nothing steered S. W. by 1 PM till noon 20 ends

Long per projection 170 45 Left had 48 30 of N

Remarks Onboard Wednesday May 15th 1850

Commenced with light breezes from N. E. all sail steering S. W. thick fog saw no whales middle part the same latter part steering S. W. fine breezes & cloudy saw plenty ducks so ends

Left had 48 00 W

Long 170 45 E

Remarks Onboard Thursday May 16th

Commenced with fresh breezes from N. E. steering S. W. cloudy bent new fore topmast stay sail at 4 PM. saw & ship to windward middle & latter part strong breezes at 10 PM took in main top sail steering S. W. at 10 AM took in main top gallant sail so ends carpenter finished cabin stairs
