

Remarks Onboard Wednesday June 5th

Commenced with moderate breezes from S.W. at 8 AM. Saw great quantity of ice some in large lumps run down to it saw one humpback bre up 8 AM. saw several ships at 7 PM ran into the ice & worked through in shore saw 15 ships 14 of them boiling some cutting whales at Cape Ennis

Lat. 62° 13'

Remarks Onboard Thursday June 6th Commenced with fine weather and S.W. wind at 10 AM. 20 miles off at 7 PM saw whales boiled & chased until 10 PM then saw several middle & latter part of day at 10 PM employed chasing whales & boat struck one parted line and 14 miles off to Westward

Remarks Onboard Friday June 7th

First part fine chasing whales 20 ships in sight mostly boiling at 1 PM foggy, double reef heading to E. to winds S.W. & S. middle part fog at 3 PM headed to W. at 11 AM found our selves close to the beach each ship stood off shore & Ennis Capt Adams Lat. by bar 62° 43'

Remarks Onboard Saturday June 8th

Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. at 4 PM. towed took a whale took him along side cut him in commenced boiling 10 Ennis 30 ships in sight cutting & boiling Lat. 63° 06'



Remarks Onboard Sunday June 9th

Commenced with fog winds to S. then employed boiling 40 ships James Allen of New Bedford & whales middle & latter part foggy so tried taring with main yard abaft Lat. 63° 06'

Remarks Onboard Monday June 10th

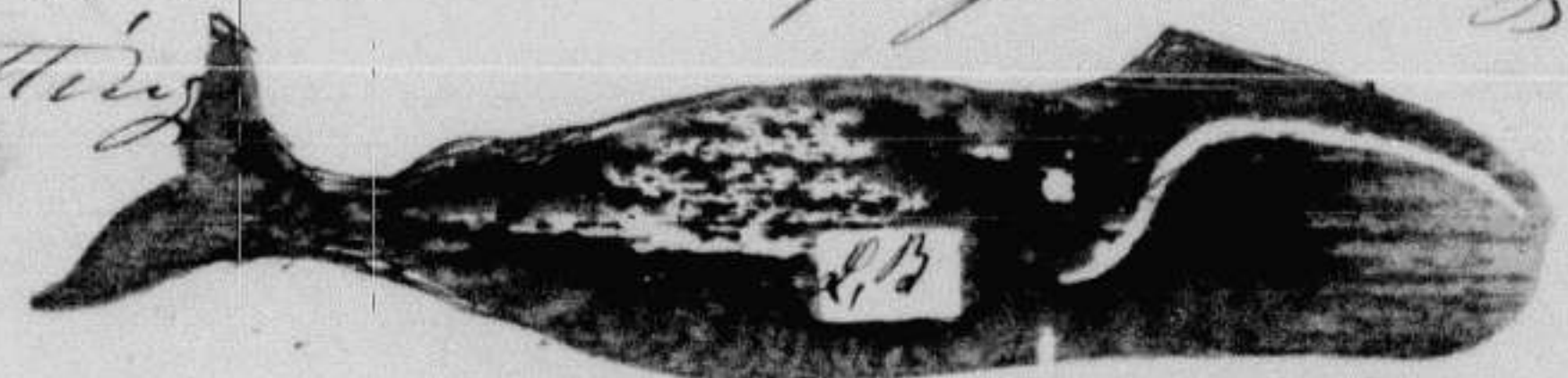
Commenced with fog winds to S.W. at 4 PM clear up chasing whales & boiling 1 boat struck & killed one took him to shore & ship cut him in Lat. in sight to 14 miles



Tuesday June 11th

Remarks Onboard Tuesday June 11th fine weather employed boiling & stowing down 1 boat took a whale along side commenced cutting

Wednesday June 12th fine weather employed boiling & stowing down finished cutting



Remarks Onboard Thursday June 13th

Commenced with fine weather employed boiling & stowing down Cape Theedeen bearing N.W. 40 miles Dist

Remarks Onboard Friday June 14th

These 24 hours moderate calm from S.W. with fog employed boiling & stowing down 3 ships in sight

Remarks Onboard Saturday June 15th

Commenced with moderate gale & fog employed boiling & stowing down heading to S.W. winds Westward to Ennis Lat. 63° 46'
