

Remarks Onboard July 25th

Begins with thick fog & fresh breezes from W. & E. put ship's head to N. by the wind commencing slowing down after heave broke off slowing at midnight rounded got bottom at 25 fathoms soft mud middle & latter part the same finis here slowing lower heave plenty whales around 10 Ends in 1st

Remarks Onboard July 26th

Begins with light air & calm thick fog search for whales to no purpose rounded point 25 fathoms in the middle part & later the same ship on 4 heavy tacks at noon got bottom at 23 fathoms shells & coarse gravel & plenty of whales all around the ship fog & rain same S. 1st by 12

Remarks Onboard July 27th

Commences with fresh breezes fog & some rain from W. & E. ship's head to E. by the wind about ship heading N. W. by the wind under 1 double reef top sails jib & staysail 10 spinnens fore reef hauled up middle part thick fog at 2 o'clock heading to W. W. at 9 AM fog lifted and one ship seen the land bearing N. W. with tacked ship's heading to E. & E. strong breezes from South & heavy tide rips current setting N. E. 24 knots at noon got an observation gave latitude 44° 46' N. Longitude 109° 23' W. Fog came in thick fog

Remarks Onboard July 29th

Begins with passing fog & wind from W. & E. 1 PM line up N. E. 4 miles saw Romandoff Island ahead 4 miles off van down west side of it hauled aback 8 1/2 lines came off to the ship for traffick left at 4 PM line up N. W. through the straits saw 8 great number of whales the fog & raged to lower for them at 8 PM Romandoff Island line W. & E. per compass 18 miles 1st thick fog & 11 that clear astern some fog ahead middle part thick fog at midnight at how the heading to N. W. at 5 PM stood to W. & E. saw 1 ship at 11 PM fog lifted ends with fresh breeze 1 June 1908.

Remarks Onboard July 30th

Begins with fine breezes from W. & E. cloudy at 1 PM saw whales at 2 PM saw 1st Island boat took 1 whale took him along side cut him in at 3 o'clock in shore & charger sail in sight found 2 native harpoon in the whale mind & 4 latter part fog & rain at 4 PM winds shifted to E. started work ended even fog



Remarks Onboard July 31st

Begins with moderate breezes from E. & thick and rain double reef the topsails laying with main yard aback heading to N. E. at 8 PM commenced heaving middle part calm at 7 PM must be heaving Boat came aboard after letters having 12 whales catch employed starting flour in to catch on 10 ends with fog & plenty mouse diggers in sight 1st 66 10

Remarks Onboard August 1st

Begins with 2 ship's wind to N. W. thick fog at 2 PM left top sails at 8 took in sail at 10 PM could not heading N. W. under close reef main top sail hauled middle & latter part more moderate thick fog employed heaving & setting up blocks
