

Remarks Onboard Aug 2nd 1850

Begins with light breeze from S.W. & thick fog, heaving to 10 miles under double reef & sails employed boiling middle part & under clear several sail in sight latter part fine weather finished boiling at 11 AM. Saw whales but not the by the kind employed & cropping. So Ends
 Lat 58° 5' N Long 170° 5' W

Remarks Onboard Aug 3rd 1850

Begins with light air from S.W. & thick fog employed a stormy between decks at 1 PM calm middle part fog latter part fine weather employed storming down at 11 AM saw 1 whale bearing N. by E. 10 miles down 125 fathoms between decks
 Lat 58° 15' N Long 170° 15' W

Remarks Onboard Aug 4th

Begins with light breeze from E. & ship heaving to 10 miles by the wind lat 1 PM 1/2 ship in sight middle part fog latter part the same from N.W. heading in shore to 10 miles saw 2 whales bore for them but purpose at 11 AM found head of fore mast & sparring in the hands of the main top gallant stay down to foremast head - So Ends

Remarks Onboard Aug 5th Begins with light air and calm. The board boat lowered struck a small boy & shore boat took him struck & killed him took him to the ship call him in at 10 PM.

Made sail thick fog clearing inshore the middle part calm & the latter part fine breeze from E. & stood close in shore. Saw one whale spoke McGowan a of New Bedford 8 miles 24 ships along shore
 Lat 58° 15' N Long 170° 15' W

Remarks Onboard Aug 6th Begins

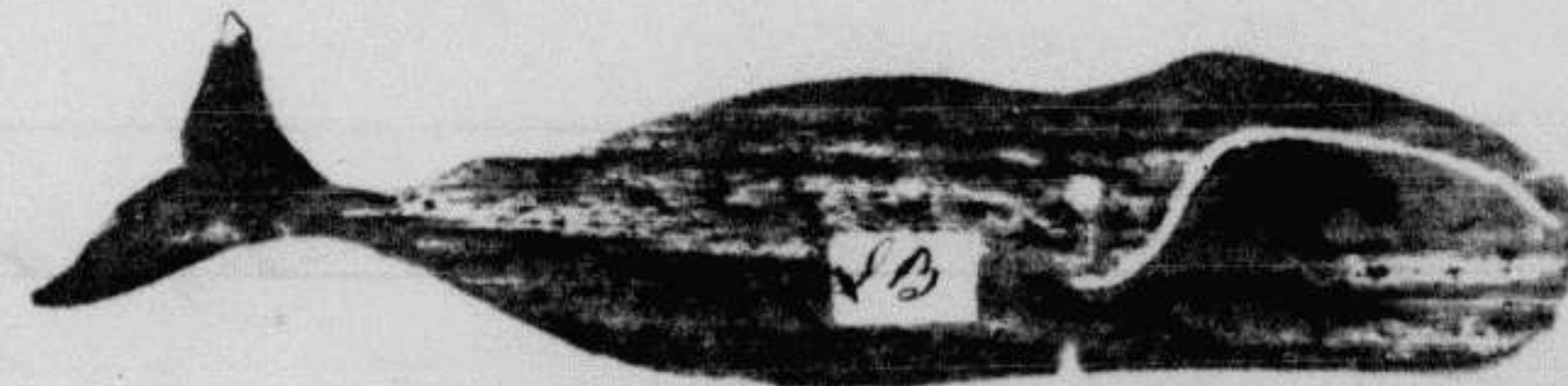
with fine breeze from N.W. & clearing along shore to 10 miles at 10 PM heaving to 10 miles at 3 AM & Cape bar E. 10 miles & took in sail have to reading off shore & blowing a gale at 10 miles later at 10 AM spoke ship Republic of Bremen 13 whales made sail here up 8 AM
 So Ends

Remarks Onboard Aug 17th

Begins with fine weather at 3 PM but the anchor made sail lowered for whales got nothing middle part thick with rain from E. & 1/2 mile - latter part fine weather employed boiling. So Ends
 George Vincent sick & one cannackas
 Lat 58° 4' N Long 173° 21' W

Remarks Onboard Aug 18th

Begins with fine weather employed boiling & chasing whales got nothing 50 ship in sight at 1 PM middle & latter part passing fog & light air from N.W. saw one whale chased him to 10 miles So Ends
 Lat 58° 15' N Long 172° 15' W



Remarks Onboard August 19th

Begins with fine breeze from N.W. saw several whales going quick to 10 miles middle & latter part fine weather saw 1 whale & boat struck one took him along side. So Ends finished boiling
 Lat 58° 15' N Long 172° 10' W

Remarks Onboard Aug 20th

Begins with fine weather employed cutting whale finished at 1 PM middle & latter part fine winds N.W. employed cropping pipes & men off duty. So Ends
 Lat 58° 4' N Long 172° 19' W

Remarks Onboard Aug 21st Begins with

fine breeze from N.W. hauling to 10 miles employed showing between decks & spoke Bark George & 1/2 ship at 10 AM 12 whales at midnight commenced boiling middle & latter part fine weather
 So Ends
