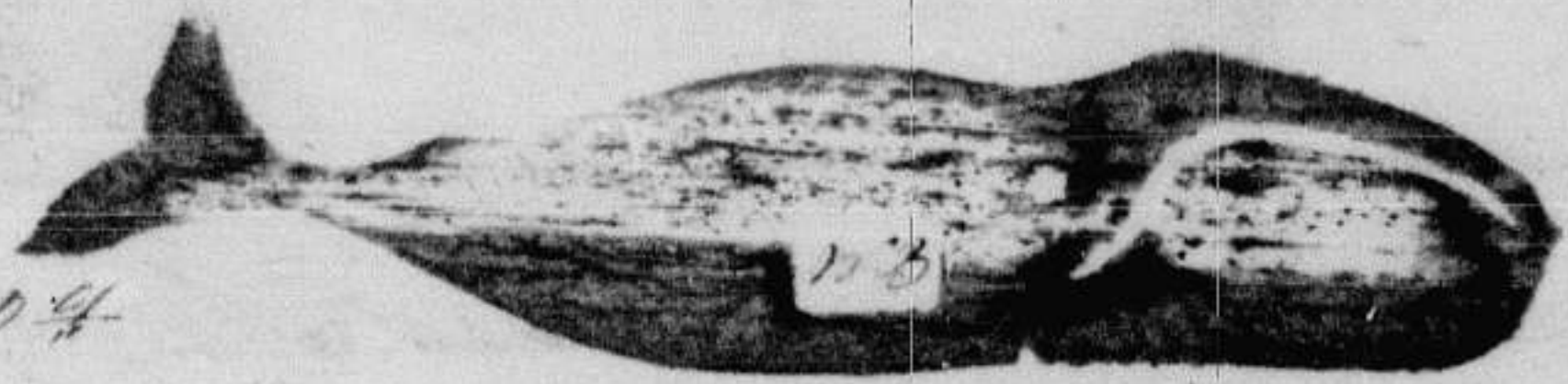




Remarks Onboard Aug 22^d

Commenced with fine weather employed hauling out 1 P.M. saw
whales several in the offing took one along side took in sail
middle & latter part strong breeze from N.E. Ends with a hal. along
side. Ends more moderate. Lett by 18 40

Remarks Onboard Aug 23^d

Begins with moderate breeze from N.E. at 1 P.M. commenced cutting
whale finished at 5 P.M. refilled throat & lefts here up N.E. made sail
for Port with light air from N.E. Ends with moderate breeze from
N.E. fine weather employed hauling & cutting up sharks at 11 A.M.
made all sail

Remarks Onboard Aug 24th

Begins with light breeze from N.E. & clear weather at 6 P.M.
luffed to the line in throat & lefts of last whale gave three
sheers for home middle & latter part breeze from N.W. blew off
the lefts got away to stow down to Ends. Lett 18 37

Remarks Onboard Aug 25th

Begins with fresh breeze from N.E. employed hauling & stowing
down & hauling several sail in sight middle & latter part
fine weather saw several ships cutting & chasing by
a plenty of whales. Lett 18 30

Remarks Onboard Aug 26th

Begins with moderate breeze from N.W. made
all sail steering N.E. & employed hauling
& stowing between decks middle & latter part
fine weather employed hauling & cutting down
Lett 18 30
Hauled ship 2000

Remarks Onboard Aug 27th

Begins with fine weather employed hauling & stowing down
Shake Bark Pieces of skin London 2900 lbs finished hauling
at 1 P.M. middle & latter part calm foggy employed coppering
& stowing down sail to Ends. Lett 17 34

Remarks Onboard Aug 28th

Begins with moderate breeze from N.E. steering N.E. & all
sail set. Piece in company middle part moderate & fine weather
about heading to N.W. at 1 P.M. breeze N.E. employed clearing
decks to Ends. Lett 18 33

Remarks Onboard Aug 29th

Begins with fresh breeze from N.E. hauled up N.W. at 3 P.M.
saw land bearing N.W. 5 miles distant shaped & course for Cape
N.E. & E. at 11 P.M. saw Cape East bearing N.W. 14 miles distant
N.E. in the street passed the Islands bearing N.E. at 3 A.M.
made all sail steering N.W. fine weather wind N.W.
Lett 18 30 1/2

Remarks Onboard Aug 30th

Begins with fresh breeze from N.W. steering N.W. all sail set
the Coast in sight to the N.W. 20 miles distant middle part the same
at 2 A.M. made South Head bearing N.W. 8 miles distant at 6 A.M.
St Lawrence Island bearing N.E. steering N.W.
to Ends one ship astern. Lett 18 33
set N.W. mast clearing sails
