

Remarks Onboard Aug 31st

Begins with moderate breeze from N.W. all sail set steering
W.M. steered to Board the bar ambient when showed it below
got ready fly jib boom for rigging out at 3 winds haul to W. to take in
steering sails middle part strong breeze soft morning top sail
latter part passing squalls at daylight so far as steaming
sail Long per chron 17940 East Lett by OBS 43 54 30

Remarks Onboard September 1st 1850

Begins with strong breeze from S.W. accompanied with passing squalls
all sail set steering W.M. middle part the same latter part
more moderate & clear Long per chron 17940 East
& men sick getting better by Observation 59 24 North
better

Remarks Onboard September 2nd 1850

Begins with moderate breeze from S.W. & fine weather at sail
set steering W.M. middle part light breeze latter part mostly
calm at 8 A.M. rigging out fly jib boom employ a drying hose
to end Long 17940 East Lett by OBS 43 54 30

Remarks Onboard Sept 3rd

Begins with light airs from S.W. at 4 P.M. put ship's head to
E.S.E. by the wind heavy weather middle part the same
latter part breeze freshens took fly jib some drift fog at
11 A.M. 2 men died in the fore-castle of S. Dienerly her
sick about 2 months since a Native of Nootka
so ends Lett by OBS 43 54 30
George about the same Long 18000 East

Remarks Onboard Sept 4th

Begins with fresh breeze from S.W. accompanied
with fog ship heading to N.E. by the wind at
6 P.M. double reef the top sail hauled aboard
& buried tack on middle part of huffing
& squally double reef latter part the
same making & taking in sail as each
requires at 10 A.M. took ship heading
W.M. by the wind George Dienerly
so ends Lett by OBS
by Reck 55 41

Remarks Onboard Sept 5th

Begins with strong breeze from North accompanied with thick fog
ship heading to N.W. by the wind under double reef courses & jib
already small setting from W. middle part moderate latter part
calm employ a cleaning ship Long 18000 East Lett by OBS 43 54 30

Remarks Onboard Sept 6th

Begins with light airs from N.W. made all sail steering
W.M. foggy weather George appears some better middle & latter
part strong breeze still thick weather Ends the same

Long per chronometer 17800 East Lett by OBS 43 54 30

Remarks Onboard Sept 7th

Begins with strong breeze from S.W. & thick fog steering W.M. all
sail set at 5 P.M. took in steering sail mid top sail at 7 P.M. in main
top a hand sail middle part. Down too blowing & gab from S.W. heavy
sea running at daylight made sail steered west at 10 A.M. took in jib
main sail so ends Long per chron 17810 East Lett by OBS 43 54 30

Remarks Onboard Sept 8th

Begins with fresh gales from S.W. at 1 P.M. observed five or six
top sail reef main with heading to W. by the wind took up lee boats
heavy sea running on the beam ship takes considerable water on
board weather thick with passing squalls middle & latter part
violent passing squalls rose ship at 11 P.M. hauled up
courses latter part under gale & heavy sea took in fore
top sail set spinnace at 5 A.M. took in top sail
Keel stove waist boat Ends with violent gale
ship heading N.W. under double reef by Reck 54 40
store reef main top sail Long 17500
& spinnace
