

### Remarks Onboard Sept 9<sup>th</sup>

Begins with violent gale from N.E. & severe squalls & heavy  
 sea running with thick weather. Ship heaves to under close reefed main  
 topsail & spinnaker heading N.W. & W. Middle part of main  
 sheeted to stick out lee bulwarks to clear water from decks cutting  
 into hull & overboard. Things went overboard continues the same  
 fog & sheet middle part. The same latter part moderates at 4 P.M.  
 at double reef topsails got at 10 P.M. for not long by chron 17745  
 at 10 P.M. Ends with some clearing set main topsails

George no better his disease appears to be 2 days longer

 at 10 P.M. } Lat 41 34' 34" N

### Remarks Onboard Sept 10<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh gale & passing squalls steering N.W. at 4 P.M. but  
 new fore sail double reefed the topsail steered N.W. Middle part  
 more moderate at 10 P.M. have too heading N.W. at 4 P.M. made all  
 sail steering N.W. cloudy with passing squalls from N.E. at noon  
 Judge our Lat to be 53 40 Long 170 40 E. No observation

### Remarks Onboard Sept 11<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fresh breezes from N.E. & with passing squalls of fog & sheet  
 steering N.W. all sail set. George very low seems to loose strength every  
 day. Middle part the same at midnight steered N.W. at 7.1.11  
 hauled up N.W. & set main sail & main topsail Ends cloudy  
 winds N.W. Lat 51-10 N  
 Long by chron 167-00 E.

### Remarks Onboard Sept 12<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fine breezes from N.W. all sail set steering  
 N.E. & E. cloudy weather at 4 P.M. set main top & all  
 set. Middle part. & latter the same and several  
 whales & Blackfish Ends steering N.E.  
 Lat 50 44 44 N

Long per chron 171 00 E  
 George very low and weak gets no  
 better yet

### Remarks Onboard Sept 13<sup>th</sup>

Begins with fine breezes from N.E. & passing clouds steering N.E.  
 all sail set watch employed scraping bone middle & latter part  
 much the same at 7.1.11 steered N.E. employed repairing main running  
 rigging - George loses strength daily more blood came from him today  
 than usual. Lat 48 08 N

### Remarks Onboard Sept 14<sup>th</sup>

Begins with moderate breezes from N.E. & passing squalls steering  
 N.E. all sail set at 8 P.M. took in steering sails & inside outside  
 middle part the same latter part blows a gale from N.E. & steering  
 by the bottom steering sail & main topsail & all sail set at 11 P.M. double  
 reefed the topsails at 11 P.M. have too under close reef main & inner  
 & spinnaker blowing & severe gale Lat 46 09 46 20 N

### Remarks Onboard Sept 15<sup>th</sup>

Begins with violent gale from N.E. & laying too heading N.E.  
 at 11 P.M. takes in main topsail & inner & outer & steering  
 takes a great quantity of water on deck stove in galley & between hull  
 middle part, more severe at day light moderates & steers N.W. at 10  
 A.M. moderates set main topsail & all sail set. Kept off N.E. by E winds  
 N.W. No End George gets no better Lat 44 11 N

### Remarks Onboard Sept 16<sup>th</sup>

Begins with moderate gale from N.W. & passing squalls &  
 clouds and a heavy cross running from N.E. & N.W. steering  
 steering N.E. & E. middle & latter part fine weather  
 Employed drying bone & repairing damages of the  
 the late gale one sail in sight to the N.W.

Commencing up with us slowly George very low  
 today & no Ends & inner mist
