Remarks Onboard Sept 18th

Begins with moderate breeze from N.W. all sail set near by S.W. at 1 P.M. have slack for a ship & come up with us at 3 P.M. Records her ship's name of ship Bedford 25 months out got some Ester Oil & Landrum from her middle & latter part baffling breeze from S.W. at 10 A.M. broke off to S.E. & S.W. George appears some better  
 Lat 43.00 Long 176.30 West

Remarks Onboard Sept 19th

Begins with moderate breeze from E. & passing shows heading to V. by the wind all sail set sailing in company middle part of breeze from S.W. took in light sails at 7 A.M. double reef the topsails blowing fresh gale from N.E. steering S. by E. ship pitches all under forward takes great quantities of water on deck at 8 took in jib at 11 moderate set jib  
 Lat 42.00

Remarks Onboard Sept 20th

Begins with moderate breeze from E. & fog all sail set heading S.W. middle part & latter baffling with strong flaws from E. at 4 P.M. at 4 A.M. double reef the topsails took in mizen topsail at 1 P.M. stood to E. wind S.W. with severe rain. E. with light breeze George some better  
 Lat 41.00

Remarks Onboard Sept 21st

Begins with moderate breeze from E. & fog, & rain at 6 P.M. fresh breeze double reef the topsails heading S.E. middle part & latter fresh gale at 11 P.M. took in fore topsail at 1 P.M. set close reef topsails at 10 reef mizen wires haul to S.W. clearing E. & S. & heavy swell running from E. & S. George the same  
 Lat 40.00  
 Long 173.00

Remarks Onboard Sept 22nd

Begins with moderate gale from W.W. clearing & E. & S. moderate set at 6 P.M. made all sail middle & latter part moderate in on haul to E. & S. with wind East thick fog, took in heading S.W. & S. George the same  
 Lat 40.00

Remarks Onboard Sept 23rd

Begins with moderate breeze from E. & S. with thick fog at 4 P.M. took in ship heading to S.W. & E. middle & latter part moderate gale from W. & S. lagged 4 hours at 1 P.M. moderate set broke out here from fore head since heading E. & S. George getting worse daily  
 Lat 41.43 Long 176.30 West

Remarks Onboard Sept 24th

Begins with moderate gale from S.W. thick & rainy heading to E. by the wind heavy by works over board & on cracked on pot. lashed spar & cork in their place middle & latter part the same, George had & very bad turn in his disease and breathed his last about 9 past 3 o'clock, civil war, } Lat 40.00  
 Remarks Onboard Sept 25th Begins with moderate gale from W. heading to E. employ as at various jobs middle & latter part more moderate & clear steering East at 1 P.M. took up the topsails nothing doing  
 Lat 41.14

At 11 o'clock on the 25th Sept. 1792 per ship 172.30  
 have a back the main topsail and committed the body of our deceased shipmate to a willing grave & beathere George J. Vincent
