

Remarks Onboard Nov 24th

Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. all sail set steering
N.E. employed bunching bone put below 37 bundles started meet
middle part light breeze at 11 AM with increasing sail hauled
courses at midday at board ship heading to S.W. by hours then
headed to E.S. Windward E. at daylight made all sail steer at N.E.
to clear an Island in the vicinity ends pleasant sail & sea
steering to S.W. by the wind got E. Lunar Observation Sept 9 18
Long 157 15 W. Lat 14 15 N

Remarks Onboard Nov 25th 1880 - Begins with light breeze
& pleasant all sail set steering N.E. middle part sail too wet till
midnight then breeze E.S. made all sail with the wind & sea
Ends the same bunching bone
Long 157 13 W. Lat 14 23 N

Remarks Onboard Nov 26th

Begins with moderate breezes from S.W. all sail set course
N.E. put below 17 bundles of Bone fitted up stays middle
part the same latter part employed bunching bone once done
steering N.E.
Long 157 10 W. Lat 14 11 N

Remarks Onboard Nov 27th

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. all sail set course N.E.
at 4 PM squally put below 26 bundles of Bone at 5 PM both
in steering sails under haffling hauling to N.E. & 112
middle & latter part passing squalls of wind & rain
Ends with E light breeze from north
Long 157 24 W. Lat 13 00 N

Remarks Onboard Nov 28th

Begins with fresh breezes from S.W. all sail set course N.E.
some passing squalls of rain one sail in sight middle & latter part
fine weather at daylight commenced drying bone once pleasant
Long 157 15 W. Lat 14 05 N

Remarks Onboard Nov 29th

Begins with light breezes from S.W. all sail set course N.E.
employed bunching bone bunched 27 bundle weighed & put below 83
middle & latter part fine weather employed on bone once done
Long 157 13 W. Lat 14 23 N

Remarks Onboard Nov 30th

Begins with a soft E wind to E.N.E. & clear finished bundling
37 bundles put below wet hauled made all sail heading North
by the wind middle part fresh breezes from E.N.E. finished bundling
bone 40 ends gone off 112 Long 155 35 W. Lat 14 41 N

Remarks Onboard December 1st 1880

Begins with fresh breezes from E.N.E. all sail set steering
N.W. & hauled a bone floor in all 232 bundles average
weight about 135 lbs middle & latter part the same
Ends with E breeze from north
Long 157 44 W. Lat 17 40 N
