

Remarks Onboard Jan 2nd 1851

Begins with strong westerly winds & passing squalls arise. E. by N. all sail set. Cooper in sight middle & latter part strong winds from N.W. with squalls taking in & making sail at occasion requires. Copper in sight at Ends with fresh gales from N.W. 143 21 knots. Lett 44 41 South

Antony & Manuel Portuguese off. Entry sick

Remarks Onboard Jan 3rd 1851

Begins with fresh gales from N.W. varying a breeze of sail steering E. by N. & heavy sea on with passing squalls at 4 PM, set lower steering sail. At 9 PM carried away fore & main top mast steering sail haws at midnight took in top gallant sails latter part more moderate at 10 AM all sail. Dr. Ends

Long 140° 40' W Lett 45 40

Remarks Onboard Jan 2nd 1851

Begins with pleasant gales from N.W. steering E. by N. all sail set middle & latter part rain, winds from N.W. carrying all present sail No Ends. Lett 50 31 1/2

Remarks Onboard Jan 3rd

Begins with strong breezes from N.W. with rain at 2 PM haws to N.W. moderates steering E. by N. at 4 PM set steering sails & main royal middle & latter part the same at 10 AM set all sail Dr. Ends

Long 131° 28' W Lett 47 29 South

Remarks Onboard Jan 4th

Begins with pleasant gale from N.W. all sail set steering E. by N. middle & latter part the same No Ends. Lett by Obs 45 23

Remarks Onboard Jan 5th

Begins with fresh gales from N.W. all present sail set steering E. by N. middle & latter part rain, middle & latter part the top sails at 7 AM shot out tops set & excellent sail. Ends with rain. Lett 48 10

Remarks Onboard Jan 6th

Begins with fresh gales from N.W. all present sail set steering E. by N. middle & latter part light rain & rain. At 10 AM light wind hawl to N.W. by lights Dr. Ends. Caught 6 porpoise. Long by Reck 121° 00' W Lett 50 31 1/2

Remarks Onboard Jan 7th

Begins with light airs from V.E. & cloudy ambient main top sail hunt another ship heading to N.E. in middle part the same. Becost meet latter part strong breezes from N.W. sent down main royal yard has the appearance of Eagle Dr. Ends. Long 120° 28' W Lett 50 31 1/2

Remarks Onboard Jan 8th

Begins with fresh gales from N.W. all present sail set steering E. at 2 PM winds shifted to N.W. moderates middle & latter part calm & light breezes from N.W. at 10 AM set steering sails. Ends cloudy.
