

Remarks Onboard Sunday Jan 9th

Begins with fresh breezes from N.E. all sail set & steering East at 4 P.M. took a small canvas away for topmast steering sail boom took in steering sails middle part & latter fore breezes all sail set & employed replacing shrouds & beams

Remarks Onboard Sun. 10th

Begins with strong breezes from S.W. all prudent sail set steering E. middle part & equally at mid night & death with the breeze latter part more moderate & wind sail

Remarks Onboard Saturday Jan 11th

Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. which at 4 P.M. at 2 P.M. breeze hauled to N.W. Barometer fell to 29 7/10 the breezes freshen steering E. under single reef topsails & main top gallant sail & set down fore top gallant yard at 4 P.M. got ready for E gale middle part the same latter part blew E fresh gale from S.W. with rain at 4 P.M. sent down main top gallant yard at 10 took in fore topsail & ends at 10 1/2 Lat 53 00 N Barometer falling

Remarks Onboard Sunday Jan 12th

Begins with fresh gales from N.W. with rain & squalls steering E. with close reef main topsail & fore sail Barometer down to 28 7/10 at 2 P.M. at 4 minutes past 11 P.M. which one reef out main topsail middle part more moderate at day light

set fore topsail turned 2 reef out the main at 10 A.M. blew on again close reef main & ends with a strong gale from West

Barometer rising to 29 7/10 Lat 53 35 N Long 103 10 W

Remarks Onboard Monday Jan 13th

Begins with strong gales from N.W. with passing squalls steering E. at 1 P.M. took in fore sail middle part more moderate at 2 P.M. reef fore sail at it turned came right out main topsail Ends with strong gales & hail squalls steering E. took in fore sail

Long 114 40 W Lat 54 50 N

Remarks Onboard Tuesday Jan 14th

Begins with strong gales from S.W. with violent heat squalls steering E. at 3 P.M. set reef fore sail middle part the same latter part more moderate & set 2 reef out the topsails set haul fore sail thus Ends Lat 54 52 N Long 104 00 W at 8 A.M.

Remarks Onboard Wednesday Jan 15th

Begins with fresh gales from N.W. all prudent sail set steering E. & some passing squalls middle part moderate at 3 P.M. commenced sending up gales crossed fore & main top gallant & royal & over set steering sails at 7 A.M. kind flight saw a sail astern humming up with us De Ends

Remarks Onboard Thursday Jan 16th

Begins with fresh breezes from N.W. & hazy at 2 P.M. ship America of New Bedford came up & spoke us steering E. at 4 P.M. set middle part & main in brace at 11 P.M. took in top gallant sail & main & lower latter part the same Lat 55 10 N Barometer 55 00 W
