spoke the brig Abbott Lawrence
capt Russell 30 crabs

S heading S by E saw 3 sails
at 4 AM saw whales in company
with the brig Abbott Lawrence
and got one 30 crabs
No oil Bate 16 05

Sunday 9 light breeze from
S by E employed cutting at 7
AM finished cutting 30 crabs
Lat 32 30 Long 45 41 Bate 17

the
Monday 10 light air and calm
employed hooling at 12 AM
finished hooling saw 2 sails
Lat 31 55 Long 46 41 Bate 17 05

the
Tuesday 11 light breeze and
variable heading W by N at 7 AM
saw whales and lowered
in company with the brig
Abbott Lawrence and got
one more 3 barrels 30 crabs
No oil Bate 17 15

Wednesday 12 light breeze from
N by W tacked retacked fast
25 fms and 26 1/2 m. saw sperm
oil on board brig Abbott Lawrence
Lat 31 17 Long 45 34 Bate 18 05

Saturday 15 light breeze from S by W
tacked retacked saw two sails 30 crabs
Lat 31 57 Long 45 59 Bate 20

the
Sunday 16 light breeze from S by W
tacked and retacked saw one sail
Lat 31 57 Long 45 42 Bate 20 5

the
Monday 17 light breeze from W
steering S by E saw one sail
Lat 31 47 Long 45 01 Bate 21

the
Tuesday 18 strong breeze and
spray all round the compass
No oil Bate 21 5

Wednesday 19 strong breeze from
S by W heading S by E 30 crabs
Lat 31 53 Long 45 48 Bate 22

Thursday 20 strong gale from S by W
