Thursday 12 light trades tacked and
retacked saw blackfish lowerd and
six took them to the ship so ends

the Date 014 37
Friday 13 light trades tacked and
retacked saw blackfish lowerd
but got none so ends

Saturday 14 light trades tacked
retacked saw nothing employed
by long blackfish so ends
Lat 07 42 Date 014 43

Sunday 15 light trades heading
N by W saw nothing so ends
Lat 07 30 Long 08 03 Date 014 46

Monday 16 light trades heading
W saw nothing this day a man
by the name of Hendrick went below
and said nothing to any officer
or to me and when the mate went
to call him he said he was not able
to come on deck and a man by the
name of back told the mate

and the captain was there
forward and did not talk any
notice of him this story came out
three days after it happened so the man
back said it does not look very
