

Remarks On Board Bark *Platina*
one Chron 40 miles out the other 40 at noon killed
two off carvo so ends this day
Tuesday July 26th

First part commences with a good breeze from the
W & W off and on at carvo at one the capt
went on shore at five came on board with onions
and potatoes got three bags put off at 6 at
Sundown carvo bearing W & W 10 miles
middle part wind N at daylight clear latter part
saw grampuses so ends this day Lat by Chron 20 20 W
Longitude Chron 20 20 W
Wednesday July 27th

First part commences with a good breeze from the W
hark heading E & E at sundown saw sperm whale
grampuses middle part wind light from the W at
daylight breezing with a heavy swell latter part fresh
breeze saw two sails steering S & E so ends this day
Lat by Chron 21 30 W
Longitude Chron 29 29 W
Thursday July 28th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from W hark steering
N & E saw steamer going to the W a hark going S & E
Sundown wind W & W with squalls of rain middle part
wind moderate latter part rain of wet light rain
light with a heavy swell so ends this day Lat by Chron 22 32 W
Longitude Chron 28 08 W

Friday July 29th Lat by Chron 28 13 W
First part commences with a light wind from the North
a heavy swell hark heading E & E middle part
calm at daylight light air from S & W latter part
same so ends this day Lat by Chron 27 46 W
Longitude Chron 27 46 W

Saturday July 30th
First part commences with a light air from S & W hark
steering E & E at sundown wind the same
middle part wind the same at daylight cloudy
latter part strong wind from the W & W with
rain so ends this day Lat by Chron

Sunday July 31st

First part commences with a strong breeze from
S & W hark steering E & E thick air raining
middle part thick fog latter part rain light
from the W & W with squalls of fog so ends this
day Lat by Chron 25 25 W Longitude Chron 27 39 W
Monday Aug 1st

First part commences with squalls of fog rain
light from the W & W hark heading E & E
middle part clear at daylight thick fog and calm
at seven cleared up rain breeze from S & W hark
heading E & E latter part rain light so ends
this day Lat by Chron 25 20 W Longitude Chron 27 36 W
Longitude Chron 27 42 W
Tuesday Aug 2nd

First part commences with a light rain from S & W hark
heading N & E middle part rain light at
six saw spouts turned out sperm whale grampuses
latter part rain once hark steering N & W so ends
this day Lat by Chron 25 45 W Longitude Chron 28 27 W

Wednesday Aug 3rd
First part commences with a good breeze from S & W
hark steering N & W saw two sails and a
steamer steering to the S middle part wind
light at daylight saw sperm whale grampuses latter part
wind light but all sail headed E & E so ends this day
Lat by Chron 26 09 W Longitude Chron 28 27 W

Thursday Aug 4th
First part commences with a light wind from S
steering E & E so sperm whale grampuses at
sundown rain middle part at daylight saw same
more grampuses a large whale at daylight wind light
latter part cloudy with light rain wind S & W
hark steering E so ends this day
Lat by Chron 26 00 W Longitude Chron 28 00 W
