Remarks on board Bark Platina

Sunday Sept 4th

First part commences with a light air from the NW off Fagal at four spoke the center middle part wind light at daylight calm latter part calm so ends this day

Monday Sept 5th

First part commences with a light wind from the NW part up and run in for Fagal at one the soft went on shore at five boat came off stood off on an middle part wind light at daylight calm at seven light wind from the NW part up and run in the passage at ten lunch came off and sent the oil on shore latter part off the town so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 6th

First part commences with a good breeze from the NW off the town at five lunch came off with the potatoes took them on board the fourth mate and cooper went in to see the doctor discharged the fourth mate James of Birmore middle part wind light at seven run in off the town capt came on board and carried the Birmore things on shore latter part wind hauled to the SE so ends this day

Wednesday Sept 7th

First part commences with a good breeze from the SE laying too off the town waiting for the capt at six capt came on board and run out the passage and took off one man as cooper put up 8 miles part wind light at daylight wind ESE peak of Fagal bearing ESE at 3 miles latter part wind the same so ends this day Lat 37 20

Thursday Sept 8th Long by Chron 27 37 W

First part commences with a good breeze from the ESE heading off at sundown took headed at E middle part wind light from ESE at daylight saw three or four islands latter part took and steered to the ESE wind employed in ships duties so ends this day Lat 37 20

Friday Sept 9th

First part commences with a good breeze from the E heading ESE at sundown took headed at E middle part wind light at daylight set a full sail latter part good breeze from ESE heading ESE so ends this day Lat 37 20 Long by Chron 26 14 W

Saturday Sept 10th

First part commences with a good breeze from the SE heading ESE at sundown wind the same middle part strong breeze from the SE heading to the SE at daylight took in sail latter part employed in ships duties the island of St Michaels bearing ESE 10 miles so ends this day Lat 37 20 Long by Chron 24 54 W

Sunday Sept 11th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the SE heading SE at sundown St Michaels bearing ESE 15 miles middle part calm daylight light air from E heading to the SE latter part wind the same St Michaels bearing SE to ESE at 20 miles so ends this day Lat 37 12 Long by Chron 23 01

Monday Sept 12th

First part commences with light air and calms at sundown calm middle part wind light from the SE at daylight St Michaels bearing ESE 15 miles latter part wind light so ends this day

Tuesday Sept 13th

First part commences with a light wind from the SSE off St Michaels at one capt went in for letters at dark came off with the E W marse as capt returned off middle part wind light at daylight had a squall of rain latter part left up - the marse came on board for his papers he left so ends this day Lat 37 11
