Remarks on Board Bark Platina

Wednesday Sept 14th

First part commences with a strong breeze and squally rain from the SSW heading SE at sundown rain the same middle part rain light at daylight light rain from WNW steering S set masts in sight heading ESE dist 25 miles latter part rain the same at ten o'clock saw a sperm whale going quick to the WSE. Lawrence two boats and gave chase so ends the day
Lat 46° 36' 42" N Long 122° 14' W

Thursday Sept 15th

First part commences with a light breeze from WNW chasing whales at four came on board at five saw the schooner C.W. Horse take a whale along side run for him at sundown put off at midnight at W light set masts heading E about 35 miles middle part rain light at daylight good breeze from the N steering S by W latter part rain the same so ends this day
Lat 46° 35' 40" N Long 122° 26' W

Friday Sept 16th

First part commences with a light rain from the N steering S by W at one saw a school of small whales going to ramblow Lawrence but whales got to ramblow the boats gave chase but did not get on sundown came on board and steered S middle part good breeze from the same at daylight steering S by W latter part employed in ships duties so ends this day

Saturday Sept 17th

First part commences with a good breeze from NW steering S by W at sundown rain the same middle part rain same at daylight light rain from WNW steering S latter part employed in breaking out so ends this day
Lat 46° 31' 46" N Long 124° 07' W

Sunday Sept 18th

First part commences with a light rain from the WNW steering S at sundown rain the same middle part light rain from N latter part rain light from N to W so ends this day

First part commences with a light air from N to W steering S middle part calm at daylight light rain from the NW to S employed in setting up fore rigging latter part light rain from N steering S W by S so ends this day

First part commences with a light rain from the N steering S W by S making on the fore rigging at sundown rain light middle part light rain from the N at daylight breeze from N to E employed in breaking out rigging and slakes latter part good breeze so ends this day
Lat 46° 29' 15" N Long 124° 24' W

Wednesday Sept 21st

First part commences with a good breeze from N steering S W by S at sundown rain the same middle part rain light at daylight good breeze from the same latter part employed in the rigging so ends this day
Lat 46° 27' 35" N

Thursday Sept 22nd

First part commences with a good breeze from the N steering S W by S employed in ships duties middle part rain light at daylight breeze from the N to E latter part employed in the rigging so ends this day
Lat 46° 25' 46" N Long 124° 47' W

Friday Sept 23rd

First part commences with a good breeze from the N steering S S W by W middle part rain light at daylight good breeze so latter part employed in the rigging so ends this day
Lat 46° 23' 48" N

Saturday Sept 24th

First part commences with a good breeze from the N steering S W by S middle part rain same at daylight rain E latter part steering down saw a steamer steering to the N to so ends this day
