Remarks On Board Bark Platina

Sunday Sept 25th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the E steering S W by W middle part rain same at daylight strong breeze from E N E latter part same so ends this day Sat by Obs 19-25-00 Long by Chron 25-24 W

Monday Sept 26th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the E to steering S W by E middle part strong breeze at daylight moderate with squalls of rain latter part rain light saw the island of St. Vincent and at the Cape de Verde bearing E by S dist 25 miles so ends this day Sat by Obs 16-5-00 Long by Chron 25-24 W

Tuesday Sept 27th

First part commences with a light rain from the E heading S middle part rain light from E S at daylight rain E N E latter part employed in setting up main topmast back stays and sail in sight steering S S W so ends this day Sat by Obs 15-50-00 Long by Chron 25-23 W

Wednesday Sept 28th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the E steering S S W middle part rain the same at daylight rain breeze from the N E latter part employed in the rigging saw a number of vessels going to the N W so ends this day Sat by Obs 13-42-00 Long by Chron 25-26 W

Thursday Sept 29th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the N E steering S S W at four past the Bark Belinda of Glasgow middle part squally with rain and wind from the E S E at daylight fresh breeze latter part rain same so ends this day Sat by Obs 11-21-00 Long by Chron 26-11 W

Friday Sept 30th

First part commences with strong breeze from E to S W at seven took rain S W heading S S E middle part rain light with squalls of rain latter part rain squalling wind so ends this day Sat by Obs 6-55-00

Saturday Oct 1st

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the N N W heading to the S middle part squally at daylight same to in light sails latter part strong breeze from S S W heading S E saw a steamer and one ship so ends this day Sat by Obs 9-20-00 Long by Chron 23-21 W

Sunday Oct 2nd

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S S W heading S E middle part squally at daylight cleared off one ship in sight steering to the S E rain S S W latter part rain same so ends this day Sat by Obs 9-00-00 Long by Chron 23-21 W

Monday Oct 3rd

First part commences with a moderate breeze from S S W to S W at sundown rain light middle part rain light from S W at daylight rain W heading S S W caught a porpoise latter part rain same saw blackish three sails in sight so ends this day Sat by Obs 8-12-00 Long by Chron 22-00 W

Tuesday Oct 4th

First part commences with a light wind from the W heading S S W middle part gale breeze from W at daylight rain W S W latter part rain the same saw four sails employed in ship station so ends this day Sat by Obs 7-10-00 Long by Chron 21-37 W

Wednesday Oct 5th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the N N W heading S at three saw breaches of spars and lab tails four points off weather saw the five or six mile off did not see them again at sundown had a squall of rain middle part rain S to S W took headed W S W to W N W at midnight started S and W S W latter part squalls of rain seven sails in sight so ends this day Sat by Obs 6-55-00
