Remarks On Bonne Back Plateau

Thursday Oct 6th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the SSW to WSW heading to the S at two came on to rain hard employed in catching water at sundown still raining hard with light rain at eight took in light sail middle part - loose off at daylight gale breeze from SSW latter part rain the same none more heard in favor of gallant blue lines so ends this day Lat by Obs 54.60 V Long by Chron 19 = 24 W

Friday Oct 7th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the SSW heading S & E three sails in right middle part rain light at daylight wind SSW heading S & E six sails latter part employed in ships duties so ends this day Lat by Obs 51.00 V

Saturday Oct 8th

First part commences with a light rain from the SSW heading S & E at four tacked head S at eight saw blackish middle part rain light from S & E steering S by W at daylight light rain calm latter part saw blackish barometer but did not stick came in haave saw two sail so ends this day Lat by Obs 49.38 V Long by Chron 18.33 W

Sunday Oct 9th

First part commences with a light rain from the SSW heading W & a signal seen an english boat came to Rio Janeiro middle part rain hauler to the W & W steered S W at daylight wind SSW heading S & E tacked latter part rain the same so ends this day Lat by Obs 40.70 V

Monday Oct 10th

First part commences with a light rain from SSW heading W at four came on rain at six tacked middle part rain wind SSW at daylight saw three sail heading to the W tacked wind out S to S & E at eleven spoke the bark the lean of new bark two masts out 19 a bell latter part rain S so ends this day Lat by Obs 35.50 V Long by Chron 18.49 W

fourth day at anchor 13.20 steady

Tuesday Oct 11th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S heading WSW under topsails at six the capst came on board middle part rain SSW at daylight wind light latter part three king accit four sail saw one sail so ends this day Lat by Obs 32.00 V Long by Chron 20.14 W

Wednesday Oct 12th

First part commences with a light rain from the SSW heading W middle part rain light at daylight same latter part employed in ships duties saw one sail so ends this day Lat by Obs 04.00 V Long by Chron 21.36 W

Thursday Oct 13th

First part commences with a fine breeze from S heading WSW middle part rain the same at daylight strong breeze latter part employed in checking out reef saw one sail so ends this day Lat by Obs 20.20 V Long by Chron 23.11 W

Friday Oct 14th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the S heading WSW middle part rain the same at daylight headed S W by W latter part saw a large ship steering S W so ends this day Lat by Obs 40.30 V Long by Chron 24.52 W

Saturday Oct 15th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the S & E heading S W at five exchanged long with a fair weather ship middle part strong breeze from S & E heading SSW at daylight same latter part employed in the rigging so ends this day Lat by Obs 14.32 V Long by Chron 25.50 W

Sunday Oct 16th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S & E to S heading from S S W to S W middle part rain the same at daylight light squally latter part rain the same so ends this day Lat by Obs 34.36 V Long by Chron 26.59 W
