Sunday Oct 17th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S & E heading S W middle part rain same at daylight rain S & E heading S S W latter part employed in ship's duties so ends this day

Lat 40° 55' S Long 128° 25' W

Tuesday Oct 18th

First part commences with a good breeze from the S & E heading S W middle part rain S & E steering S S W at daylight same latter part raining in the night so ends this day Lat 40° 43' S Long 128° 56' W

Wednesday Oct 19th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E heading S S W middle part good breeze steering S by W at daylight same latter part employed in the rigging so ends this day Lat 40° 50' S Long 128° 56' W

Thursday Oct 20th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E heading S S W saw one sail going to the S middle part rain S & E at daylight rain the same latter part employed in the rigging so ends this day Lat 40° 11' S Long 129° 05' W

Friday Oct 21st

First part commences with a good breeze from the S & E heading S S W middle part rain S & E heading S by W at daylight saw breaches all weather bar did not see them again latter part saw a barkteen heading to the S saw pinheads so ends this day Lat 40° 15' S Long 129° 49' W

Saturday Oct 22nd

First part commences with a strong breeze from S & E steering S W middle part fresh breeze took in light sails at daylight rain the same latter part rain moderate set the main topgallant sail and spruce, the yard sent it down and fished it so ends this day Lat 40° 16' S Long 129° 26' W

First part commences with a good breeze from the S & E steering S by W employed in fishing the gaud at five sent it off and sent the S middle part good breeze from the S at daylight rain S & E latter part same so ends this day Lat 40° 19' S Long 129° 15' W

Monday Oct 24th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E heading S & E at seven rain light middle part head S & E at daylight saw marten was rocks bearing S & E at 15 miles at eight men in a fishing latter part rain the same so ends this day Lat 40° 50' S Long 128° 48' W

Tuesday Oct 25th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E at three had come off caught about forty one mile sail steering S & E middle part good breeze from S & E at daylight rain the same breeze up and of the hands and the breeze the rig latter part rain the same so ends this day Lat 40° 37' S Long 128° 06' W

Wednesday Oct 26th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E steering S & E middle part rain S & E at daylight rain the same latter part employed in ship's duties so ends this day Lat 40° 26' S Long 127° 10' W

Thursday Oct 27th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E steering S & E middle part rain the same at daylight rain light latter part employed in setting all the rigging so ends this day Lat 40° 20' S Long 126° 26' W

Friday Oct 28th

First part commences with a good breeze from S & E steering S middle part rain the same at daylight part took the beam brace and bread and plan latter part rain hail and S with rain and breeze so ends this day S & E
