Remarks On board Bark *Statina*
Saturday Dec 3rd

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S W cruising 3000 yds number of finbacks at 10:15 saw two right whales hauled but did not strike came on board middle part calm at daylight light rain from the S at 10:15 saw two right whales marking to the S hauled but did not see them again latter part rain light so ends this day Lat 41° 37' 10" S Long 174° 31' E

Sunday Dec 4th

First part commences with a light rain from the S evening middle part good breeze at daylight breezing up latter part saw finbacks so ends this day Lat 41° 37' 44" S

Monday Dec 5th

First part commences with a strong rain from the S at 10:15 came on rain tank in suit to lower topsails at 10:15 cleared up rain hauled to the S W middle part rain light at daylight good breeze from the W W heading to the S W at eleven saw a large sperm whale heading to the S W he is going quick so ends this day Lat 41° 38' 38" S Long 174° 26' E

Tuesday Dec 6th

First part commences with a good breeze from the W W hauled a sperm whale at 10:15 hauled and the S W hauled a boat saw an and struck got two small holes stove in at eleven tank him along side at daylight hauled an and got his body in about mid night so ends this day Lat 41° 38' 38" S

Wednesday Dec 7th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S W hauled on the head latter part got it on deck so ends this day Lat 41° 38' 38" S Long 174° 11' E

Thursday Dec 8th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S W at 10:15 started fires middle part wind the same at seven saw a right whale hauled and the S W hauled a boat struck and cleared chases all day came on board at 10:15 so ends this day Lat 41° 38' 38" S

Friday Dec 9th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S employed in hauling middle part thick and rainy latter part rain breezed so ends this day Lat 41° 36' 35" S

Saturday Dec 10th Long 174° 10' 17" E

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the S employed in hauling middle part wind hauled S W and breezed up to a moderate gale with a heavy swell latter part same so ends this day Lat 41° 37' 28" S

Sunday Dec 11th Long 174° 10' 30" E

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the W W laying toat employed in hauling middle part moderating at daylight strong breeze from the W tank a cask away from the cabin and fetched away and heat one man to her part moderate so ends this day Lat 41° 36' 57" S Long 174° 10' 28" E

Monday Dec 12th

First part commences in hauling with a strong breeze from the S W middle part wind the same at daylight got all up out of the blubber room and washed out latter part finished hauling and cleared up deck so ends this day Lat 41° 37' 03" S

Tuesday Dec 13th Long 174° 10' 28" E

First part commences with a good breeze from the S W clearing up middle part wind the same at daylight got ready to start down latter part light rain so ends this day Lat 41° 37' 25" S Long 174° 10' 28" E

Wednesday Dec 14th

First part commences with a good breeze from the W hauled down at midnight finished at daylight wind the same saw a whale ship at 10:15 a boat from the whale came along side latter part saw two more whale ships so ends this day

Thursday Dec 15th Lat 41° 37' 14" S Long 174° 10' 28" E

First part commences with a good breeze from the W at 10:15 saw a right whale hauled and last boat started did not fasten at 10:15 spoke the S W the S W middle part wind light at daylight light rain from the S hauled a main rigging and got it up three sails in right so ends this day
