Remarks On Board Bark *Platina*

Monday Dec 26th

First part commences with a light wind from the N at three spoke the *Scathleen* sundown took in sail middle part wind the same at daylight and breeze from the W at W made all sail at sight but off ESE in company with the *Kathleen* latter part bent a new mizzen topsail so ends this day.

Tuesday Dec 27th Tully by Chron 112 20 E

First part commences with a gale breeze from the W at W steering ESE at sundown wind the same middle part wind the same daylight took in fore topmast staysail to appear latter part wind the same *Scathleen* in sight so ends this day. Tully by Obs 3720 PS

Wednesday Dec 28th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the W at W steering ESE at sundown took in light sails middle part wind fresh at daylight running with a smart breeze with mizzen topmast sail latter part wind the same *Scathleen* in sight so ends this day.

Thursday Dec 29th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the W at W steering ESE at sundown took in lower topsails and fore sail middle part wind the same at daylight fresh breeze from the W latter part set fore topmast sail so ends this day. Tully by Obs 37-20 PS Tully by Chron 20-53 E

Friday Dec 30th

First part commences with fresh breeze from the W steering ESE at three spoke at sundown took in to close reef mizzen topmast and staysail and hauled to the S at W middle part wind the same at daylight put off ESE set fore topsail at nine breeze up to a gale hauled to the N at W and W latter part took in mizzen topsail and a merchant bark turned up after her had so ends this day. Saturday Dec 31st

First part commences with a heavy gale from the N at W laying two heading ESE at sundown wind the same middle part wind changed to the W wind moderate with heavy swell at daylight wind light employed in breaking out mizzen latter part put off ESE and three sails so ends this day. Tully by Obs 37-22 PS Tully by Chron 21-35 E

Sunday Jan 1st

First part commences with a light wind from the N at W with a heavy swell steering ESE at sundown wind the same middle part wind the same at daylight wind light from W at E latter part fore sail wind hauled E at noon calm cleared off so ends this day. Tully by Obs 37-30 PS Tully by Chron 21-52 E

Monday Jan 2nd

First part commences with a calm at four light air from the E heading S at sundown the same middle part wind hauled W at W steering ESE at daylight gale breeze latter part wind the same so ends this day. Tully by Obs 38-00 PS Tully by Chron 23-18 E

Tuesday Jan 3rd

First part commences with a gale breeze from the W at W steering ESE at sundown took in to lower topsails middle part wind W at daylight wind the same steering E latter part wind hauled S at W hauled S at E so ends this day.

Tully by Obs 37-05 PS Tully by Chron 25-35 E

Wednesday Jan 4th

First part commences with gale breeze from the S at W heading SE at sundown cloudy took in sail middle part wind S at W at daylight gale breeze latter part wind hauled S at E heading to the E employed in breaking out keep so ends this day.
