

Remarks On Board Bark Platina

Wednesday Jan 18th

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the S & heading E in company with canvas exchanged frequently signals middle part rain the same at daylight same latter part rain S & E to S & at ten made sail so ends this day. Lat by Obs 33=07 Long by Chron 37=31 E

Thursday Jan 19th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the ESE heading E & canvas in sight a two spoke sundown pay squalls middle part rain strong from ESE midnight staid to the S daylight rain light latter part same so ends this day. Lat by Obs 33=03 Long by Chron 37=54 E

Friday Jan 20th

First part commenced with a light rain from the E at dawn came on pay that in sail at nine hours a light bar canvas middle part pay at daylight same with a light air from NW latter part clear off so ends this day. Lat by Obs 33=48 S Long by Chron 38=04 E

Saturday Jan 21st

First part commenced with a light air from the W steering ESE in company with canvas sundown took in light sails middle part rain hail SW at daylight rain S & heading E latter part rain the same so ends this day. Lat by Obs 33=58 S Long by Chron 39=23 E

Sunday Jan 22nd

First part commenced with a strong breeze from the S & heading E in company with the canvas at six exchanged Long with flags middle part rain the same daylight strong breeze at nine tacked to the S latter part thick and heavy weather so ends this day. Lat by Obs 34=04

Monday Jan 23rd

First part commenced with a strong rain from the ESE heading to the S in company with the canvas sundown shorted sail middle part rain the same daylight rain S & E latter part rain light so ends this day.

Tuesday Jan 24th

First part commenced with a light rain from the ESE heading to the S middle part rain. Should S & W tender S & E daylight set off sail at nine came on to blow thick in all but however sails, latter part quite a heavy gale canvas in sight so ends this day. Lat by Obs 34=58 S Long by Chron 40=34 E

Wednesday Jan 25th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from SSW at dawn. Moderate rain with a heavy swell middle part rain same daylight rain light mist in fore part and took care of water latter part rain light breeze S & E so ends this day. Lat by Obs 35=02 E Long by Chron 40=54 E

Thursday Jan 26th

First part commenced with a light air from the S & heading E middle part calm daylight same at eight light rain from NW latter part S & E in company with canvas latter rain light so ends this day. Lat by Obs 35=38 S Long by Chron 41=12 E

Friday Jan 27th

First part commenced with a light rain from the NW steering S & E in company with canvas sundown saw distant lower a boat middle part rain latter part light air from SW so ends this day. Lat by Obs 35=51 S Long by Chron 41=38 E

Saturday Jan 28th

First part commenced with a calm at two had recall of rain light air from the sundown light air from SSW middle part same daylight rain from S & E latter part heading E and day in getting underway boat ready to start so ends this day. Lat by Obs 35=08 S Long by Chron 42=12 E

Sunday Jan 29th

First part commenced with a light air from S & heading E sundown rain S & E heading S middle part rain S & E to S at daylight rain S & E latter part light air and calm so ends this day. Lat by Obs 35=34 S Long by Chron 42=11 55 E
