

Remarks On Board Bark *Platina*Monday Feb 13th

First part commences with a light air from WSW with a heavy swell steering ESE & sundown most calm middle part wind S W to E squally daylight rain & heading S latter part rain & heading ESE & sea ends this day

Lat 39° 39' S Long 138° 52' W

Tuesday Feb 14th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the WSW steering ESE with rain & sundown rain the more middle part heavy squally rain & rain daylight and W steering ESE for St. Pauls island latter part breeze up fresh so ends this day

Lat 38° 45' S Long 138° 52' W

Wednesday Feb 15th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the WSW steering ESE at three o'clock sighted and passed us to the W of the Chum about 35 miles at nine and a half saw the island bearing ESE 20 miles hauled up ESE & at sundown the island bearing ESE 12 miles a tight traking suit up hauled the middle more moderate at daylight island bearing ESE 12 miles latter first two boats went in fishing came off at noon and put off ESE & sea ends this day Lat 38° 30' S

Thursday Feb 16th

Long 138° 52' W

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the WSW the cantan hauled too came on board and got some fish put off ESE & in evening at nine island bearing ESE 12 miles a tight traking suit up hauled the middle more moderate at daylight island bearing ESE 12 miles latter first two boats went in fishing came off at noon and put off ESE & sea ends this day

Friday Feb 17th

Lat 39° 45' S

First part commences with a gale breeze from W steering ESE & spoke the cantan came on squally commencing a heavy middle part wind breezed up fresh daylight heavy squalls from WSW running to the ESE & latter part rain the same cantan in sight so ends this day

Lat 39° 55' S

Long 138° 46' W

Saturday Feb 18th

First part commences with a moderate gale from the WSW running ESE & sundown more moderate middle part fresh breezes from WSW daylight rain the same latter part breezing cantan in sight so ends this day

Lat 39° 45' S Long 138° 52' W

Sunday Feb 19th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the WSW steering ESE & sundown rain the same middle part rain the same daylight cloudy with a gale breeze latter part same cantan in sight so ends this day

Lat 39° 55' S Long 138° 46' W

Monday Feb 20th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the WSW steering ESE & middle part came on thick fog rain & day daylight fine rain and fog latter part rain light from WSW cleared in cantan in sight so ends this day

Lat 39° 45' S

Tuesday Feb 21st

Long 138° 52' W

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the WSW steering ESE & middle part rain light daylight and latter part same so ends this day

Lat 39° 45' S

Wednesday Feb 22nd

Long 138° 52' W

First part commences with a light air from WSW steering ESE & at nine middle part rain light daylight and latter part rain same so ends this day

Lat 39° 45' S Long 138° 52' W

Thursday Feb 23rd

First part commences with a light air from ESE & at nine hauled up the keel and headed ESE & sundown gale breeze from SSW middle part gale breeze from WSW latter part rain light rain WSW so ends this day

Lat 39° 55' S Long 138° 46' W

Friday Feb 24th

First part commences with light rain from WSW steering ESE middle part gale breeze from W at daylight light squalls rain latter part strong breeze so ends this day
