Saturday Feb 20th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the W steering E middle part fresh breeze to in light sail daylight set top gallant sails latter part same so ends this day Lat 35 33 S Long 106 58 E

Sunday Feb 21st

First part commences with a strong breeze from the W steering E by N at four miles back and hauled the main sheet middle part same the same latter part cloudy so ends this day no obs

Monday Feb 22nd

First part commences with a gale breeze from the W steering E by N middle part nine light latter part gale breeze so ends this day Lat 36 45 S

Tuesday Feb 23rd

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the W steering E by N middle part nine light daylight nine S latter part calm so ends this day Lat 36 18 S Long 113 05 E

Wednesday Feb 24th

First part commences with a calm at two light wind from the W steering E by N sundown gale breeze from the S steering E by N middle part nine hauled S latter part strong breeze saw a large ship steering N by W so ends this day Lat 35 26 S Long 115 17 E

Thursday March 1st

First part commences with a strong wind from S E heading E by N at sundown took in main and fore part first De. On the eastern hearing N E by E Dist 15 miles middle part nine E midnight headed in daylight fresh breeze latter part saw the land at noon steered off so ends this day Lat 34 50 S Long 118 50 E

Friday March 2nd

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the S E heading off S middle part main ship and steered in daylight strong breeze saw the canton at nine saw the land latter part same the same steered off so ends this day Lat 35 07 S Long 116 08 E

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S E heading off at two spoke the canton sundown took in sail middle part same to same at daylight fresh breeze latter part employed in washing ship so ends this day Lat 35 17 S

Sunday March 4th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the S E heading to the E middle and latter part same the same so ends this day no obs

Monday March 5th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the E by S heading to the E at four miles white top rocks bearing E by N dist 3 miles middle part same at daylight fresh breeze standing in latter part nine the saw at noon Chatham Island bearing E by N dist 10 miles so ends this day Lat 35 17 S

Tuesday March 6th

First part commences with fresh breezes from the S E heading to the E middle same latter part breezes the same so ends this day Lat 35 58 S Long 116 24 E

Wednesday March 7th

First part commences with fresh breezes from the E by S with a heavy swell middle and latter part fresh breeze so ends this day Lat 35 11 S Long 116 12 E

Thursday March 8th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the S E heading in at five steered off Chatham Island bearing E by N dist 10 miles middle and latter part fresh breezes so ends this day Lat 35 30 S Long 116 50 E

Friday March 9th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the E heading to the E saw a large steamer sailing to the W middle nine hauled E by N headed S E and E by S latter part nine light set light sails so ends this day

Saturday March 10th

First part commences with a light wind from E by S steered to the S at sundown calm middle and latter part nine light saw the land Cape Horn bearing N by E dist 12 miles so ends this day Lat 35 48 S Long 117 31 E
