 Remarks on Board Bark *Platina*

Sunday March 11th

First part commenced with a light air from S.W. at one o'clock hauled S.E. and breeze up at seven o'clock off Cape Horn bearing S.W. by W. dist 8 miles and left island bearing S.W. by W. dist 15 miles and strong breeze took in the lower topsails middle part moderate at day light Cape Horn bearing S.W. by W. dist 15 miles latter part strong off wind a steamer going to the S.W. and ends this day

Monday March 12th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the E. at six o'clock in middle part blew fresh took in to lower topsails and stood to the E. S. E. at daylight when the W. blowing fresh latter part moderate so ends this day

Tuesday March 13th

First part commenced with a light air from S.W. at two o'clock hauled S.W. and breeze up put off at 4 o'clock and made S.W. bearing S.W. by W. dist 12 miles middle part strong breeze from the W.S.W. latter part stood off at eight o'clock and hauled S.W. by W. dist 15 miles and ends this day

Wednesday March 14th

First part commenced with a good breeze from W.S.W. at daylight made all sail and stood in to King George's Sound middle part rain the same latter part making up the sound and ends this day

Thursday March 15th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the W.S.W. beating up at one o'clock came on board at two o'clock anchored under sail and worked off at daylight pilot came off and took us in the harbor the wind light from S.W. by W. dist 15 miles middle part calm in morning and getting ready for water latter part light so ends this day

Friday March 16th

First part commenced with a fine breeze from S.W. by W. middle part enclosed in fog latter part wind light so ends this day

Saturday March 17th

First part commenced with a light air from the E. at daylight got ready for water painting ship middle part took off small craft latter part wind light so ends this day

Sunday March 18th

First part commenced with a calm at daylight still calm and water on shore an arrow middle part wind light latter part same so ends this day

Monday March 19th

First part commenced with a calm at daylight sent in raft for water middle part got off about 95 bbls took off 15 sacks of potatoes mudum caught an arrow latter part calm so ends this day

Tuesday March 20th

First part commenced with a light air from the E. at daylight sent in raft for water middle part took off raft latter part calm so ends this day

Wednesday March 21st

First part commenced with a light air from the W. at daylight calm sent in a raft for water middle part took it off and sent in another part got it off. Latter part wind light from the E. an English man of war anchored so ends this day

Thursday March 22nd

First part commenced with a light air from the E. at daylight rain breeze up from S. and water on shore middle part fresh breeze got four cask water latter part moderating so ends this day

Friday March 23rd

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S. at daylight strong rain got off one raft water water on shore middle part fresh breeze latter part wind the same so ends this day
