 Remarks On Board Bark *Platina*

Wednesday April 4th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the E at daylight put off W of middle part came on sailing off mid part hauler out WSW line in sight shallows hearing of WSW dist 24 miles latter part cleared sight three off saw killers sundown saw more sa ends this day
Lat 46° 00' Long 117° 00'

Thursday April 5th

First part commenced with a strong breeze from WSW at daylight came on heavy squalls took in fore sail at noon at 10 heavy gale with squalls took in main to sail at 10 in fore part took in middle part at 11. blowing latter part rain at midnight moderate set main to sail sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Friday April 6th

First part commenced with a strong breeze from SSW at daylight saw the land cape name hearing of E dist 15 miles seven off moderate set all sail hauled to the E middle part mid light sundown had heard hearing of E dist 15 miles stage WSW latter part came breeze up from E took in sail and loaded up sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Saturday April 7th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from W at daylight cape name hearing of W dist 30 miles at light of 10 saw the caution showing whales at nine boat struck middle part strike caution whale legging SSW latter part steered SSW at 10 saw a lone whale heading WSW latter part W Boat went on but did not fasten whale went to landward saw an arrow sundown took in sail sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Sunday April 8th

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from W at daylight moderate gale middle part rain middle part latter part heavy swell from W at sundown stage of W sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Monday April 9th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from SW at daylight wind the same with heavy swell from the SW employed in repairing barefoot mast stay sail middle part hauler off E latter light squalls of rain saw the land mt Gardner hearing of E dist 35 miles sundown rain & sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Tuesday April 10th

First part commenced with a light wind from the SE at daylight made all sail saw pinkbacks and grampuses middle light air latter part employed in shepherding cluster sundown breeze light hearing of dist 25 miles hand head hearing of WSW saw the caution sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Wednesday April 11th

First part commenced with a light air from W at daylight wind breeze from SSW made all sail middle part rain SSW latter part spoke caution sundown light air from S sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Thursday April 12th

First part commenced with a light rain from the E at daylight strong breeze steered off SSW middle and latter part rain breezing sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Friday April 13th

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from the E at daylight moderate gale middle part rain latter part moderate sundown strong breeze sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'

Saturday April 14th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the N at daylight set off sail saw a number of pinkbacks middle part rain light saw the land dist 25 miles latter part spoke caution sundown rain E sa ends this day
Lat 46° 35' Long 117° 00'
