

Remarks on Board Bark Platina

Monday July 9th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the N heading to the W at daylight breezing up at nine at which time a heavy gale with heavy squalls from N W turned up the bay lee hauled latter part still blowing heavy rain hauled to the S W at sundown moderate same at midnight moderate at daylight set lower topsails so ends this day

Lat 35.44 S Long 118.23 E

Tuesday July 10th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the W N W middle part rain same noon haul to the S same W latter part breezing up and squally at midnight cleared off and moderate so ends this day

Lat 35.44 S Long 119.03 E

Wednesday July 11th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S S W headed W at daylight rain W middle part rain same noon the haul not good and hearing of W last 30 miles employed in breaking out provisions latter part breezing up and squally from W S W sundown moderate gale at midnight haul a gale from N E S W took in topsails so ends this day

Thursday July 12th

First part commences with a gale from the S W at seven at which haul to the W N W middle part same latter part moderate same at sundown fresh breeze at midnight rain same so ends this day

Lat 35.20 S Long 119.00 E

Friday July 13th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the S W to W S W at daylight haul to the N W middle and latter part rain same at sundown haul S S E at midnight rain same so ends this day

Lat 35.17 S Long 119.20 E

Saturday July 14th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the N W heading off S W at daylight set topsails middle part moderate same latter part rain the same at midnight rain W S W heading off W so ends this day

Lat 36.14 S Long 119.40 E

Sunday July 15th

First part commences with light rain from W S W at daylight light rain from S S W heading W set all sail middle part calm latter light rain from the E steering W at midnight rain hauled to the N E so ends this day

Lat 36.40 S Long 119.16 E

Monday July 16th

First part commences with a light rain from the N E at daylight rain hauled to the N W and breeze up middle and latter part rain the same at sundown took in sail at midnight rain hauled to the W and breeze up so ends this day

Lat 35.57 S Long 118.16 E

Tuesday July 17th

First part commences with a moderate gale from the W S W with squalls of rain at daylight breezing middle part fresh gale latter part moderate same haul to the W N W sundown squally at midnight moderate so ends this day

Lat 36.19 S Long 117.44 E

Wednesday July 18th

First part commences with a strong breeze from the W at daylight set lower topsails at eight saw the cutter middle part breezing squally big the cutter latter part moderate gale from W N W at midnight smart gale so ends this day

Lat 35.35 S Long 117.44 E

Thursday July 19th

First part commences with gale from S W at daylight moderate same set main topsail middle part heavy squalls latter part set foretopsail and to forest staysail sundown more moderate cutter in sight at midnight moderate to light rain squalls this day
