Sunday July 29th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S. S. W. at daylight hauled in and commenced to cut middle part cutting latter part same at nine P.M. finished cutting in the body cleared up decks and got supper at midnight with from S. W. saunders this day

First part commenced with a light rain from S. heading W. at daylight rain the same with a heavy squall from S.
