Wednesday Aug 8th.

First part commenced with a strong breeze from N. West at daylight rain the same the breeze down low 29 ft. the lowest the voyage middle part squally latter part rain breeze at sundown moderate gale rain hauled to W. S. West from rising at midnight rain moderate and hauled to the S. West sails this day.

Thursday Aug 9th

First part commenced with fresh breeze from N. West squally daylight same middle part rain hauled in a squall to the S. West sailing breeze 29 ft. latter part rain at sundown same at midnight fresh gale from the S. West sails this day.

First part commenced with a gale from S. West at daylight commenced to moderate middle part fresh breeze latter part same at midnight rain S. West sails this day.

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the W. at daylight rain same at seven P. M. saw a lane sperm whale heading to the E. got breakfast and lowered so he once out of the boat and lost the run of him middle part came on board and steered E. S. E. latter part hauled E. at four P. M. hauled on the wire to the N. W. W. sundown took in sail at midnight rain hauled E. W. headed to the W. S. W. sails this day.

First part commenced with a fresh breeze from W. S. W. to S. W. middle and latter part same with squalls of rain and hail at midnight rain same sails this day.

First part commenced with a strong breeze from W. S. W. at seven P. M. put off at E. set fore sail middle part rain W. saw the lane cape name hearing at E. dist 22 miles latter part steered S. E. to sundown took in to clear main top sail at seven P. M. wind at W. at midnight blew fresh from the W. sails this day.
