Remarks On Board Bark Platina Tuesday Oct 23rd

First part came on with a fresh breeze from the S.E. steering W by N at daylight all sail set middle part more moderate latter part rain hauled to the S.W. West sundown hauled to the S. at midnight wind light so ends this day

Wednesday Oct 24th

First part came on with a light rain from the S.W. steering to the W by N at daylight rain same middle and latter part rain light from the S. bent the main top gallant stay sail at midnight wind hauled to the W and hauled back to the E. so ends this day

Thursday Oct 25th

First part came on with a light rain from the E. steering W by N employed in setting up mizzen stay and jib gages middle part rain S.E. latter part settling light down great squalls sundown gave breeze at midnight wind same so ends this day

Friday Oct 26th

First part came on with a fine breeze from the E.S. East steering W by N employed in setting up the fore topmast stays middle and latter part same fine P.M. finished at midnight wind S.W. at daylight same so ends this day

First part came on with a moderate breeze from N.W. steering W by N employed in ship's duties middle and latter part same sundown gave breeze steering W.N.W. at midnight fresh breeze from N.E. so ends this day

First part came on with a good breeze from the N.E. steering W.N.W. middle part rain hauled out W and moderate latter part calm at sundown light rain from S.W. at midnight rain hauled to the E. and breeze up so ends this day

First part came on with a strong breeze from the N heading W.N.W. at daylight thick morning took in light sails middle and latter part same at three took in to lower topsail at five P.M. rain hauled to the W and cleared off and moderate at nine P.M. set topsails at midnight rain same so ends this day

First part came on with a good breeze from the N heading W.S.W. middle and latter part same moderate at midnight wind breeze up from the N so ends this day

First part came on with a strong breeze from the N heading W.N.W. at seven A.M. blew the jib and the rope took it out another one middle part y came on a gale from N.W. took all but main topsail latter part came on equally took in main topsail and gave ship head to the N. at sundown clear off till blowing with a heavy swell at midnight moderate set lower topsails rain hauled W heading N.W. so ends this day

First part came on with a strong breeze from the W heading N.W. at daylight made sail middle part rain hauled N.W. and breeze up latter part thick at one P.M. hauled to the N.W. sundown took all but lower topsails at midnight rain wind the same so ends this day

First part came on with a fresh breeze from the W.W. at daylight rain hauled W.N.W. at seven started to the N middle part moderate gale latter part same at midnight rain hauled to the W.N.W. and moderate same heavy swell running from S.W. so ends this day
