Thursday Nov 15th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the E steering W by North middle part employed in clearing away and painting it latter part wind E by S at midnight wind the same so ends this day

Friday Nov 16th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the E steering W by North middle part employed in breaking out and stopping a leak in the starboard pump latter part wind same sundown finishes stowing app at midnight wind same so ends this day

Lat 24° 45' Long 75° 10' E

Saturday Nov 17th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the E steering W by North middle part same employed in taking and painting latter part wind S by E sundown gale breeze at midnight wind same caught a porpoise so ends this day

Lat 24° 46' Long 75° 35' E

Sunday Nov 18th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the S by E steering to the W by North all sail set middle and latter part wind same at midnight wind same so ends this day

Lat 24° 42' Long 74° 54' E

Monday Nov 19th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the S by E steering W by North employed in taking down middle and latter part same fresh breeze sundown steering W by North at midnight came on squalls of rain so ends this day

Tuesday Nov 20th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the E by S with squalls of rain at daylight cleared app wind hauled E middle and latter part employed in taking at midnight wind the same so ends this day

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the E steering W by North at daylight wind the same middle and latter part employed in taking down at sundown gale breeze from same at midnight wind light so ends this day

Thursday Nov 22nd

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the E steering W by North daylight wind same middle and latter part employed in getting up main rigging sundown mast cald at wind light so ends this day

Lat 25° 09' S Long 61° 39' E

Friday Nov 23rd

First part commences with a light rain from the E daylight wind same employed in taking at eleven o'clock raised a shout of sperm whales going to the East middle part got ready to lower latter part gale breeze at one P.M. hummed but they got to midnight at two & P.M. came on board and put up our canvas at sundown wind the same at midnight wind light so ends this day

Lat 25° 12' Long 60° 37' E

Saturday Nov 24th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the E steering W by N daylight sent the foresail down to repair middle and latter part mending went at sundown finished and beat at midnight wind light so ends this day

Sunday Nov 25th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the E steering West middle and latter part wind light from S so ends at midnight wind light so ends this day
