

Remarks On Board Bark Platona

Friday Jan 25th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S at daylight made all sail and steered E S E employed in cleaning and painting anchors middle part rain S W latter part same at one P.M. saw the coast of America bearing E dist 20 miles At three P.M. steered E at sundown took in sail and hauled to the main at midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 14^o 37' E Long 110^o 45' E

Saturday Jan 26th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S W at daylight made sail put off of the employed in ships duties middle and latter part same at sundown took in sail hauled in the rain to the W midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 18^o 55' S Long 101^o 17' E

Sunday Jan 27th

First part commenced with a light rain from S W with rain at daylight cleared up made all sail and steered E by middle and latter part rain same saw the land about 20 miles at sundown took in sail and hauled to the W midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 13^o 42' S Long 112^o 22' E

Monday Jan 28th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the W daylight made all sail headed W by W employed in cleaning the main less and painting it middle and latter part rain same at sundown took in sail at midnight rain same so ends the day Lat 11^o 28' S Long 101^o 50' E

Tuesday Jan 29th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S W heading to the E and W at daylight made all sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same at sundown took in sail at midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 10^o 05'

Wednesday Jan 30th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S W daylight made all sail sent down the main sail to reefed middle and latter part rain same at one P.M. finished main sail and bent it at sundown took in light sail at midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 12^o 10' S Long 91^o 01' E

Thursday Jan 31st

First part commenced with a calm at daylight light air from S E set all sail headed S E W sent down main topsail to reefed middle and latter part calm at one P.M. finished the topsail and bent it at sundown calm middle part rain light from S E so ends the day Lat 18^o 55' S Long 90^o 03' E

Friday Feb 1st

First part commenced with a light rain from the S E heading S W employed in ships duties middle and latter part same at sundown calm midnight rain breeze up from S E W so ends the day Lat 19^o 07' S Long 84^o 46' E

Saturday Feb 2nd

First part commenced with a light rain from the S W heading W all sail set employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same at midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 15^o 12' S Long 81^o 16' E

Sunday Feb 3rd

First part commenced with a light rain from the S S W heading W middle and latter part rain same at midnight rain light from S S E heading S W so ends the day Lat 15^o 10' S Long 71^o 32' E

Monday Feb 4th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S S E heading S W by W at daylight light squalls of fine rain employed in cleaning chancery table middle and latter part rain light at sundown rain S S W at midnight rain same so ends the day Lat 15^o 23' S Long 61^o 54' E
