Monday Mar 24th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from S E at daylight commence shipping and middle part finishes the last shipper taking aboard 60 bbls latter part getting ready for water middle part calm so ends this day

Tuesday Mar 25th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from S E employed in taking water and setting up shooles middle and latter part same so ends this day

Wednesday Mar 26th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from S E employed in stowing off hole and setting up shooles and taking water middle and latter part same midnight wind light so ends this day

Thursday Mar 27th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S E employed in part duties and watch and liberty middle and latter part employed in stowing off midnight wind light so ends this day

Friday Mar 28th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S E employed in part duties and watch and share liberty middle and latter part employed the same so ends this day

Saturday Mar 29th

First part commences with a good breeze from the S E employed in washing ship the vessel sailed 11th heard of R. Tucker and Stuffer latter part good breeze midnight wind light so ends this day

Sunday Mar 30th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S E nothing doing and watch and liberty middle and latter part good breeze at large cables ship arrived in midnight calm so ends this day

First part commences with a good breeze from the S E at daylight wind same getting off potatoes middle part all ready for sea latter part wind light midnight wind same so ends this day

Tuesday April 2nd

First part commences with a moderate breeze from S E with squalls of rain at eight o'clock the anchor and stand out and laced off and on for the capten and shipper men at eleven. At eight o'clock un hauled and stowed to the S latter part strong breeze employed in stowing cables sundown is sun bearing W S W dist 8 miles midnight wind same so ends this day no Oles

Wednesday April 3rd

First part commences with a good breeze from the S E to E S E heading on oblique to the E at daylight light squalls of rain employed in ship's duties middle and latter part same set up fore top gallant mast stays sundown wind S E heading E at midnight wind S E so ends this day

Thursday April 4th

First part commences with a good breeze from the S E heading to E S E at daylight wind same employed in ship's duties middle and latter part same sundown rain light from S S E at midnight wind S S E heading E so ends this day

Lat 13 22 Long 31 28

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S E heading E at daylight wind S E employed in ship's duties middle and latter part same at sundown wind S S E heading E midnight wind light so ends this day
