Wednesday April 17th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.W. evening daylight saw the canton employed in ships duties, middle part rain light latter part same at two P.M. saw the canton sailing at three lowered canton boat struck and pulled him ashore went to the S.W. at five P.M. saw a must boat struck a small whale with one of the canton crews in his track him along side put up one tuchel and took him in an deck got supper and cleared him away middle part rain same so ends this day

Lat 10 24 S Long 10 08 E

Thursday April 18th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.W. evening daylight got ready to move saw blue fish going to midward middle part light rain latter part same at midnight rain light so ends this day

Lat 10 10 S Long 9 46 E

Friday April 19th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S.S.W. evening daylight rain same employed in ships duties middle and latter part same a whale the canton midnight rain same so ends this day

Lat 10 24 S Long 10 27 E

Saturday April 20th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S.S.W. evening daylight a turtle pines saw campish middle part finished hailing turn in 3 1/2 hrs sundown good breeze from S.W. midnight good breeze from S.W. so ends this day

Lat 10 44 S Long 10 54 E

Sunday April 21st

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S.W. evening nothing rainy middle and latter part rain the same canton in sight sundown strong breeze at midnight rain the same so ends this day

Lat 11 10 S Long 11 25 E

Monday April 22nd

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S.W. evening daylight moderate breeze with light squalls at rain middle part clear off latter part headed to W.W. canton in sight at sundown took in light sails midnight fresh breeze so ends this day

Lat 11 23 S Long 11 20 E

Tuesday April 23rd

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S.W. at daylight put up at S.W. in company with canton middle and latter part rain same saw black fish sundown headed to the W. and took in sail at midnight wind S.W. so ends this day

Lat 11 04 S Long 10 07 E

Wednesday April 24th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S.W. at daylight made sail and put up at S.W. in company with the canton employed in getting up spare topmast rigging middle part headed to the S.E. latter part saw canton blackfishing at four P.M. lowered but did not get an sundown took in sail midnight rain same so ends this day

Lat 10 12 S Long 9 25 E

Thursday April 25th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S.S.W. at daylight made sail headed to the W. in company with canton employed in ships duties middle and latter part same sundown took in sail headed to the S.W. at midnight wind light so ends this day

Lat 10 15 S Long 9 25 E

Friday April 26th

First part commenced with a good breeze from the S.S.W. evening daylight made all sail middle and latter part rain light saw blackfish lowered and struck tub S. Boat and La Boat took them along side and took an deck cleared away sundown took in light sails
