Saturday April 27th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. cruising day light made sail ready to the W. employed in making blackfish middle finished latter part rain light sundown took in upper tops and midnight strong breeze so ends this day

Sunday April 28th

First part commences with a gale breeze from S.W. cruising middle and latter part same at one saw blackfish however did not see them again came on board and spoke the captain at sundown took in the lower tops sails midnight same the same so ends this day

Lat 29° S Long 9° 06' E

Monday April 29th

First part commences with a gale breeze from S.W. cruising day light made sail and started fire and hailed the blackfish middle part finished latter part rain same sundown took in light sails midnight same so ends this day

Lat 29° S Long 10° 05' E

Tuesday April 30th

First part commences with a gale breeze from the S.W. cruising day light made sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part same at five P.M. saw blackfish however did not get an came on board and took in light sails midnight same so ends this day

Wednesday May 1st

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S.S.W. heading to the W. day light set all sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part same sundown headed S.S.E. in rain S.W. took in light sail so ends this day

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the S.W. cruising day light made sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part same sundown cloudy midnight rain light from W.S.W. so ends this day

Saturday May 4th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from the W.S.W. to S.W. heading to the S. employed in ships duties middle and latter part same sundown rain light midnight headed to S.W. so ends this day

Lat 11° 05' S Long 11° 46' E

Sunday May 5th

First part commences with a moderate breeze from W.S.W. to S.W. cruising day light rain light murthering cloudy middle and latter part gale breeze midnight fresh breeze from S.S.W. took in light sail so ends this day

Lat 12° 10' S Long 11° 39' E

Monday May 6th

First part commences with a fresh breeze from the S.S.W. heading W. employed in ships duties latter middle and latter part rain same sundown more moderate midnight fresh breeze took in upper topsails so ends this day

First part commences with fresh breeze from the S.S.W. employed in ships duties middle part stand to S.E. latter part rain same sundown heavy swell from S.W. midnight rain same so ends this day
