

Remarks On Board Bark *Platina*

Wednesday May 8th

First part commenced with a fair breeze from the W cruising day light made sail saw two sails eastward and at R Tucker middle part main light latter part spoke the hooker at sundown took in light sails midnight rain same so ends the day Lat 12° 36' S Long 91° 35' E

Thursday May 9th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S W cruising day light made all sail hooker in sight employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain light at sundown about calm midnight rain light so ends the day Lat 12° 32' S Long 100° 2' E

Friday May 10th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S S W cruising day light rain same employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain light at sundown rain W heading S S W midnight rain W S W light so ends the day Lat 12° 37' S Long 100° 39' E

Saturday May 11th

First part commenced with a light rain from S W day light rain light at seven miles hauls at W heading S S W employed in ships duties middle part rain same latter part hauls to the W saw pinbacks sundown all sail set midnight rain light from S W so ends the day Lat 13° 25' S Long 110° 05' E

Sunday May 12th

First part commenced with a light rain from S W heading S S E day light rain same nothing doing middle and latter part Wind W S S W to W at sundown rain very light from W at midnight storm to S W W rain W so ends the day

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the W heading at W W employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same saw a sail the S R, Tucker sundown rain light from S W midnight rain same so ends the day Lat 14° 18' S Long 111° 08' E

Tuesday May 14th

First part commenced with a fair breeze from the S W day light saw pinbacks employed in ships duties middle part breezing up latter part took in light sails at five P M took in upper topsails and main course at sundown fresh breeze at midnight moderated so ends the day Lat 14° 12' S Long 101° 12' E

Wednesday May 15th

First part commenced with a fair breeze from S S W cruising day light set topsails employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same at midnight moderate so ends the day Lat 14° 20' S Long 100° 20' E

Thursday May 16th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S S W cruising day light made all sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same sundown took in light sails midnight strong breeze so ends the day Lat 14° 38' S Long 110° 04' E

Friday May 17th

First part commenced with a fair breeze from the S S W cruising employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same at sundown took in sail rain breezing at midnight rain the same so ends the day
