First part commenced with a gale breeze from S. S. W. cruising daylight set topsails nothing doing middle and latter part in moderate squalls took in sail midnight wind same so ends this day
Lat 14 45 S Long 9 10 E

Monday May 20th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the S. W. cruising daylight made sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part in the same squalls took in upper topsails midnight wind same so ends this day

Tuesday May 21st

First part commenced with a gale breeze from S. S. W. cruising daylight made sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part in the same squalls took in sail hauled to the W. midnight wind light so ends this day

First part commenced with a light rain from S. S. W. at daylight made sail put off at W. W. employed in ships duties middle part in the same latter part put off at E. squalls took in sail hauled to the W. midnight wind light so ends this day
