

Remarks On Board Bark Platina

Wednesday May 29th

First part commenced with a gale breeze from the S W at daylight made sail a seven of all put off at 11 W employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same at three heads of E by that sundown took in sail hauled to the E midnight rain the same so ends this day Lat 11 04 S Long 9 45 E

Thursday May 30

First part commenced with a light rain at day light made sail at seven started off at 11 W employed in ships duties middle part rain very light from W S W latter part same saw a sail hauled before the A B Tucker heading to S E sundown took in light rain midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 10 30 S

Friday May 31st

First part commenced with a light rain from S W at daylight made all sail at eight at 11 calm at ten & saw a sperm whales going to the S E however did chase them at noon struck five to B & West that one to B a latter part light breeze from W at seven at 11 got the last one along side took in sail and got supper set watches midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 10 37 S Long 10 40 E

Saturday June 1st

First part commenced with a light air at day light hauled any cut at noon got sail in latter part rain light from the N at two finished cutting and commenced clearing away heads at four at 11 started fires at seven set watches midnight calm so ends this day Lat 10 35 S Long 11 05 E

Sunday June 2nd

First part commenced with a calm employed in hauling and cutting up blubber middle part calm latter part calm at four finished cutting up at seven set watches at eight at 11 light air from S W headed to the W night rain light so ends this day

Monday June 3rd

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from the S W employed in hauling mild to and latter part calm at seven at 11 light air from same midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 10 00 S Long 11 11 E

Tuesday June 4th

First part commenced with a light air from S W employed in hauling at eight at 11 finished and washed off middle and latter part rain light sundown took in light sails midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 10 04 S Long 10 30 E

Wednesday June 5th

First part commenced with a light rain from S W at daylight set light sails employed in ships duties middle part rain same latter part humped salt water ready to stow a/c middle part rain light so ends this day

Lat 10 23 S Long 10 35 E

Thursday June 6th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S W at daylight got ready to stow a/c employed in stowing down at ten finished middle and latter part light air from the E midnight calm so ends this day

Lat 10 05 S Long 10 55 E

Friday June 7th

First part commenced with a light air from S at daylight saw a sail employed in ships duties middle part light air from the W at one at 11 spoke the captain latter part rain W at sundown took in light sails midnight rain light so ends this day

Lat 10 05 S Long 11 09 E

Saturday June 8th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from S W daylight made all sail employed in ships duties middle part calm latter part same at sundown took in light sails light air from S W went on in night midnight rain light so ends this day
