

Remarks On Board Bark Platina

Sunday June 9th

First part commenced with light rain from S W at seven saw a schooner battam made all sail & started off N W weather being middle and latter part rain light at three bells at E canton in sight sundown took in light sails hauled to the S at midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 10.50 S Long 10.12 E

Monday June 10th

First part commenced with a light breeze from the S at daylight part off at E made all sail saw a pinkish employed in breaking out provisions middle and latter part rain same sundown took in sail hauled to the E canton in sight midnight rain light same so ends this day Lat 10.50 S Long 9.50 E

Tuesday June 11th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S W evening daylight made all sail employed in ships duties middle part rain light latter part spoke canton sundown took in sail midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 10.52 S Long 10.56 E

Wednesday June 12th

First part commenced with a light rain from S W at daylight set all sail evening employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same sundown took in light sails canton in sight midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 9.57 S Long 11.28 E

Thursday June 13th

First part commenced with a light rain from S W at daylight made all sail headed to the W employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same at sundown took in sail canton in sight midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 9.58 S Long 11.28 E

Friday June 14th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from S at daylight made all sail employed in ships duties middle and latter part rain same sundown took in sail canton in sight midnight rain light so ends this day Lat 9.45 S Long 10.55 E

Saturday June 15th

First part commenced with light rain from S W evening daylight made all sail saw blackish employed in taking out part pump and stapes a black middle and latter part rain same sundown took in sail midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 9.48 S Long 9.51 E

Sunday June 16th

First part commenced with a moderate breeze from S W evening daylight made all sail saw blackish going to sundown middle part saw canton evening blackish latter part saw hunchacks going to S E at two till spoke canton sundown rain light from W S W midnight rain light same so ends this day Lat 9.54 S Long 10.12 E

Monday June 17th

First part commenced with a light air from S E daylight calm employed in taking out the starboard piece and piece it middle part it back latter part light air from S W sundown same midnight rain light canton in sight so ends this day Lat 9.50 S Long 10.11 38 E

Tuesday June 18th

First part commenced with a light air from S W at daylight saw blackish hunchack and S E Boat struck one and lost him came on board middle part rain light latter part breeze up canton in sight midnight rain same so ends this day Lat 9.48 S Long 10.11 50 E

Wednesday June 19th

First part commenced with a light rain from the S evening at daylight made all sail at nine at 11 saw some whales called them a sperm whales lowered and went to them turned out hunchacks mast had struck and turned him up near at him along side at ten at 11 got ready and cut him in pieces and at two till started fires at sundown took in sail canton in sight midnight rain breeze same so ends this day Lat 9.45 S Long 10.37 E
